PURPOSE: The purpose of this legislation is to amend Rule 5 of the Rules of Order for Standing Committees of the Navajo Nation Council such that meetings shall be cancelled if a quorum cannot be established within one hour after the scheduled start time of the meeting.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

A. The Health, Education and Human Services Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council. The Health, Education and Human Services Committee, among other powers, is authorized "to review and recommend resolutions relating to social services, health, environmental health, education, veterans, and veteran services, employment and labor." 2 N.N.C. §§ 400 (A), 401 (B)(6)(a).

B. The Resources and Development Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council. The Resources and Development Committee, among other powers, is authorized "to promulgate rules and regulations governing

1 transportation, community development, local government units, land
2 acquisitions for the Navajo Nation, environmental protection, and the use,
3 sale, exchange and development of Navajo Nation lands and/or resources,
4 whether held in fee or trust status.” 2 N.N.C. §§ 500 (A), 501 (B) (1).

5 C. The Budget and Finance Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo
6 Nation Council. The Budget and Finance Committee shall exercises oversight
7 authority including but not limited to budget, finance, investment, bonds,
8 contracting, insurance, audits, accounting, taxes, loans, and Chapter budget
9 and finance. ” 2 N.N.C. §§ 300 (A), 300 (C).

10 D. The Law and Order Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation
11 Council. The Law and Order Committee, among other powers, is authorized
12 “to review and make recommendations to the Navajo Nation Council on
13 proposed amendments to and enactments to the Navajo Nation Code.” 2
14 N.N.C. §§ 600 (A), 601 (B)(14).

15 E. The Navajo Nation Council established the Naabik’iyáti’ Committee as a
16 Navajo Nation standing committee. All proposed legislation that requires final
17 action by the Navajo Nation Council, shall be assigned to the Naabik’iyáti’
18 Committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A) (9), 700 (A).

19 F. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation and as
20 such has the authority to promulgate rules, regulations and procedures for the
21 conduct of its meetings and that of its committees. 2 N.N.C. §§ 102 (A),(E).

22 **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

23 A. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C § 183 (E), “[a] quorum shall be required to commence a
24 standing committee meeting and for vote affecting a resolution.”

25 B. Rule 5 of the Rules of Order for Standing Committees of the Navajo Nation
26 Council, as most recently amended by CJA-08-18, requires a roll call be
27 conducted and for a simple majority of members to be present in order to
28 establish a quorum for the Standing Committee meeting.

29 C. Pursuant to Rule 25 of the Rules of Order for Standing Committees of the
30 Navajo Nation Council, amendments to the Rules “shall become effective

1 upon adoption by the Navajo Nation Council, or at such time as may be
2 specified by the Navajo Nation Council.”

3 D. The Navajo Nation hereby finds that it is appropriate for Standing Committee
4 meetings to be cancelled if a quorum is not established within one hour after
5 the scheduled start time in order to promote punctuality and efficiency.

7 **SECTION THREE. AMENDING RULE 5 OF THE RULES OF ORDER FOR**
8 **STANDING COMMITTEES OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL SUCH THAT**
9 **FAILURE TO SECURE A QUORUM WITHIN ONE HOUR AFTER THE SCHEDULED**
10 **START TIME SHALL RESULT IN A CANCELLED MEETING**

12 The Navajo Nation Council hereby amends Rule 5 of the Rules of Order for
13 Standing Committees of the Navajo Nation Council, as most recently amended by
14 CJA-08-18, as follows:

16 **RULES OF ORDER**
17 **FOR STANDING COMMITTEES**
18 **OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL**

20 **Rule 5. Roll Call/Quorum:**
21

22 The personnel of the Office of Legislative Services assigned to the Committee
23 shall perform the roll call for the morning and afternoon sessions and inform the
24 Chairperson if a quorum exists. A simple majority shall constitute a quorum. If a
25 quorum is not established within one hour of the scheduled start time of the
26 meeting, the meeting shall be cancelled.

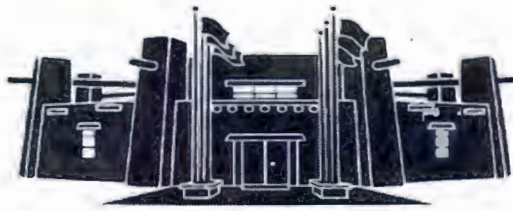

2 of Order for Standing Committees of the Navajo Nation Council.



4 **SECTION 4. SAVINGS CLAUSE**

5 Should any provision of this Act be determined invalid by the Navajo Nation
6 Supreme Court, or the District Courts of the Navajo Nation without appeal to the
7 Navajo Supreme Court, those provisions of the Act not determined invalid shall
8 remain the law of the Nation.

The Office of Legislative Counsel recommends the appropriate standing committee(s) reviews based on the standing committees powers outlined in 2 N.N.C. §§ 301, 401, 501, 601, and 701. Nevertheless, "the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council shall introduce [the proposed resolution] into the legislative process by assigning it to the respective oversight committee(s) of the Navajo Nation Council having authority over the matters for proper consideration. 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(5).

Please review the proposed resolution to ensure it is drafted to your satisfaction. If you approve, please sign as "Primary Sponsor" and submit it to the Office of Legislative Services where the proposed resolution will be given a tracking number and referred to the Office of the Speaker. If the proposed legislation is unacceptable to you, please contact me at the Office of Legislative Counsel and advise me of the changes you would like to make to the proposed resolution.
