RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

23rd NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL -- Fourth Year, 2018

AN ACTION

RELATING TO RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE, BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE; NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE AND THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$700,000.00 (SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS) FOR PURCHASE OF DIVISION OF NATURAL RESOURCES DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES FIELD OFFICES; WAIVING 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I) AND 860(C) RELATING TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITIES

- A. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (L), "[t]he Navajo Nation Council may adopt and approve supplemental appropriations to the Annual Comprehensive Budget during the fiscal year. Supplemental appropriations of General Funds within the current fiscal year are permitted, if and when additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections are projected and which are also in excess of the reserve amount set forth at § 820(J)."
- B. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 300 (C)(1)(3) and (4) the Budget and Finance Committee is authorized to recommend adoption of resolutions related to the expenditure of the Nation's financial resources.
- C. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 501 (C)(1), the Resources and Development Committee is the oversight committee for the Navajo Nation Division of Natural Resources, Department of Water Resources.
- D. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(9), a proposed resolution that requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee before it is heard by the Navajo Nation Council.

SECTION TWO. TITLE 12 FINANCE ACT SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION PROCESS AND THE TITLE 12 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS

A. The Title 12 Finance Act Supplemental Appropriation requirements include:

- Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(L), when the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections, supplemental appropriations may be allocated by the Navajo Nation Council.
- 2. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (L), "Supplemental appropriations made from non-recurring revenues shall only be made for non-recurring operations or purposes, as set forth at § 820 (F). The Controller of the Navajo Nation shall be responsible for designating recurring and non-recurring revenues and purposes."
- 3. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(M), all requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget ("OMB") for budget impact analysis.
- B. The Title 12 Capital Improvement Process includes:
 - Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 810(F), "Capital Improvement" means a major project undertaken by the Navajo Nation that is generally not recurring on an annual basis and which fits within one or more of the following categories:
 - All projects requiring debt obligation or borrowing;
 - (2) Any acquisition or lease of land;
 - (3) Purchase of major equipment or vehicles, with a life expectancy of five years or more, valued in excess of an amount to be established by the Controller;
 - (4) Major building improvements that are not routine maintenance expenses and that substantially enhance the value or extend the useful life of a structure;
 - (5) Construction of new buildings or facilities including engineering, design, and other preconstruction costs with an estimated cost in excess of an amount to be determined by the Controller; and/or
 - (6) Major equipment or furnishing required to furnish new buildings or other projects, the cost of which is above a certain amount to be established by the Controller.

- 2. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (I), the "[d]evelopment of the Capital Budget shall be coordinated with development of the Operating Budget. All budget requests for capital improvements shall be in compliance with an adopted Capital Improvement Plan and shall not be approved unless in compliance with the Plan."
- 3. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (M), the Office of Management and Budget shall coordinate the overall preparation, adoption and implementation of both the annual operating and capital budgets of the Navajo Nation. All requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget for budget impact analysis and other appropriate action.
- 4. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 501 (B)(4)(c), the Resources and Development Committee is to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council through the appropriate process supplemental appropriations to the capital improvement projects annual budget to fund necessary additional capital improvement projects.
- 5. 12 N.N.C. Ş 860 (C) (2) "[t]he Pursuant to appropriation portion of the Capital Improvement Plan is subject to approval of the Navajo Nation Council upon recommendation of the Budget and Finance Committee. Any modification or amendment affecting the approved Capital Improvement Plan is subject to review and concurrence by the Resources and Development Committee prior to consideration by the Navajo Nation Council."

SECTION THREE. FINDINGS

- A. The Division of Natural Resources, Department of Water Resources has made a request for Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance (UUFB) for purchase of the Department of Water Resources Field Offices. The budget documents regarding this request are attached as **Exhibit C**.
- B. The purchase of the Department of Water Resources Field Offices are not included in the Title 12 Capital Improvement Plan because the Capital Improvement Plan was rescinded by Navajo Nation Council by CAP-23-17. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(L), the attached memorandum, Exhibit A, the Office of the Controller has identified the additional

revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections.

- C. The Office of Management and Budget's Impact Analysis of the Department of Water Resources Field Offices is attached as **Exhibit B**.
- D. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (L), the attached memorandum, Exhibit A, from the Office of the Controller specifies this request for supplemental appropriation as non-recurring costs.
- E. As set forth in a memorandum from the Office of the President and Vice-President dated February 29, 2016: "The most needed development for the Navajo Nation Government is office space. This is absolutely necessary and essential for our government to be able to carry out its functions to the Navajo People." See attached Exhibit D.
- F. The Navajo Nation finds it in the best interest to waive Capital Budget and Capital Improvement Plan requirements as stated in 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I) and 860 (C) regarding the purchase of the Department of Water Resources Field Offices.
- G. The Navajo Nation finds it in the best interest to approve Supplemental Appropriation of Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) for the purchase of the Department of Water Resources Field Offices.

SECTION FOUR. WAIVING 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I) AND 860 (C) REGARDING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROCESS FOR PURCHASE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES FIELD OFFICES

The Navajo Nation Council hereby waives 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(I) and 860(C) with regard to the Capital Improvement process and purchase of the Department of Water Resources Field Offices.

SECTION FIVE. APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT UNRESERVED, OF \$700,000.00 FOR PURCHASE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES FIELD OFFICES

A. The Navajo Nation Council, having received certification by the Office of the Controller of the availability of certain funds from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance (UUFB) for supplemental appropriation hereby approves the supplemental appropriation of Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) for purchase of the Department of Water Resources Field Offices. B. This supplemental appropriation of Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) shall be from that amount of funds that exceeds the minimum fund balance of the UUFB.

Pursuant to Executive Order No. 07-2013, the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) reviewed the proposed document and provides the following:

- 1. Appendix K submitted by the program indicates there are no alternative funding source being pursued. OMB is aware of the Permanent Trust Fund 5 year Plan, whereby \$5.85 million is identified for office buildings under Year 4. See attach page from resolution CAP-19-16. Further, available funds are in the Sihasin Fund.
- 2. The budget package as submitted seeks funds from the Undesignated, Unreserved Fund Balance (UUFB) to purchase office buildings for five (5) Water Resources suboffices in Manyfarms, Chinle, Pueblo Pintado, Ganado, and Leupp. There are no documents included in the 164 packet such as quotations, etc., to support how the \$700,000 was arrived at, and the cost for each facility.
- 3. Buildings are capital items and as such should comply with the requirements under the Appropriations Act. 12 NNC Section 820 (I), requires that capital budgets comply with an adopted Capital Plan. Currently, there is no approved plan. Additionally, the DCD Capital Projects Management Department should have a comprehensive overall plan for capital needs. There are many other needs besides these five (5) buildings.
- The project proposal without any written documentation by the Division of Community Development-Capital Projects Management Department appears to not have been reviewed as required by NNC 12, Section 860 (A)
 Certain criteria regarding the project proposal are to be met as approved by the Division of Community Development's oversight committee.
- 5. The Navajo Nation approved the Fiscal Year 2018 budget legislation, CS-53-17, and directed the Branch Chiefs of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branches to prioritize the unmet needs of their respective branches and to prepare appropriate budgets for such prioritized needs for potential consideration of supplemental appropriations in Fiscal Year 2018 in accordance with 12 NNC Section 820 (L). Only the Judicial Branch has done so with the prioritized list attached as Exhibit L to the budget legislation.
- 6. See attached marked-up budget for corrections to be made.
- 7. The 164 review document is insufficient. The above should be addressed before any funding legislation is introduced.

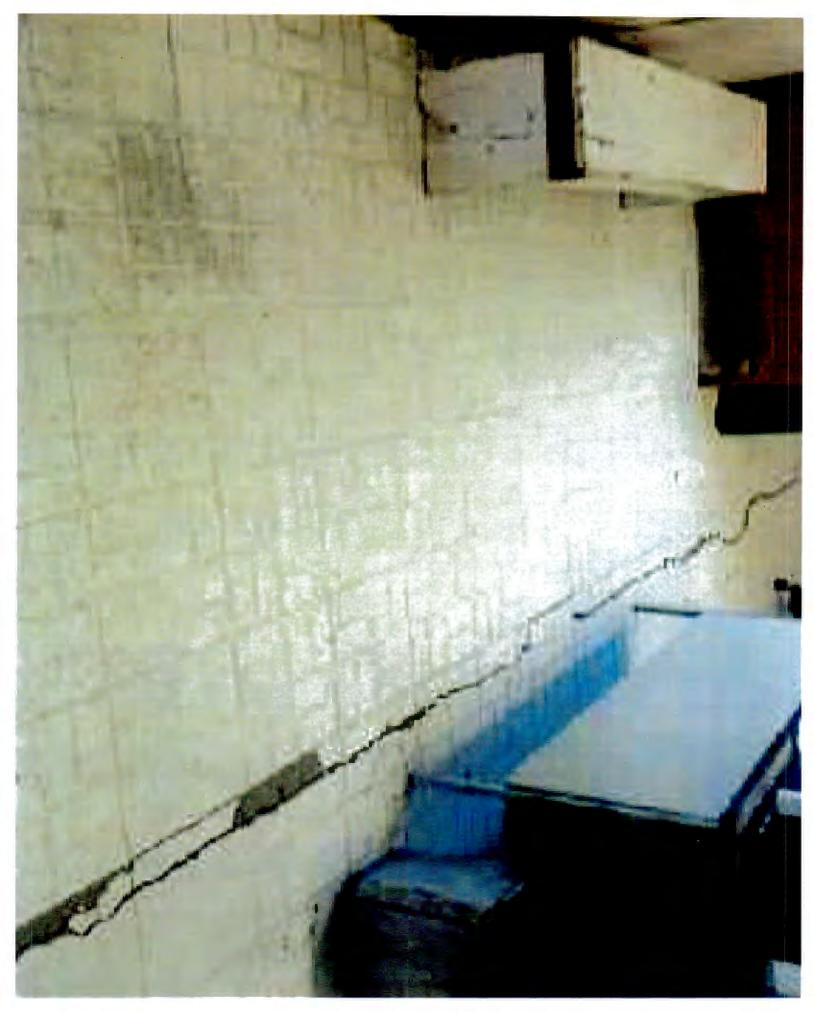


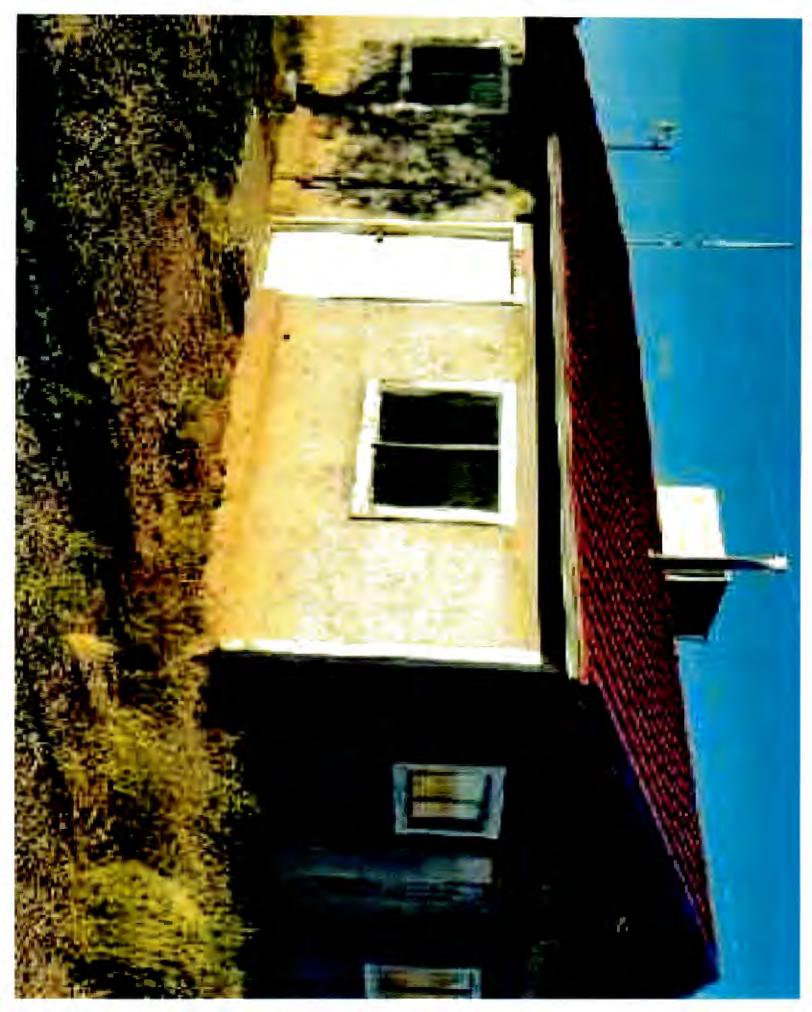

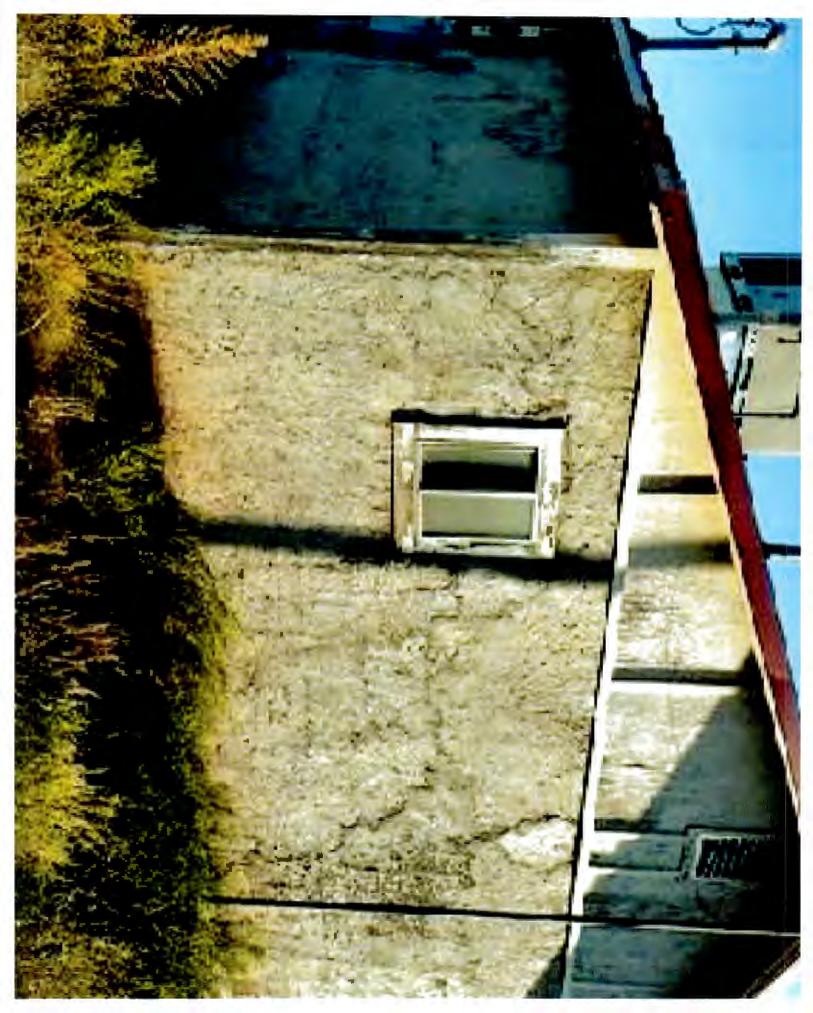

SUBJECT: Fire Incident Report

Had a normal cold day, went home at 5 p.m., Raymond Ramone, Equipment Operator was the last to lock up because he waited around for some people to get water from our yard, a lady by the name of Grace Tsosie's children, who reside northeast of Pueblo Pintado.

I went home and was running some errands, picking up my mail by the highway, when a text message was to my wife's phone by my son. It read dad your shop is on fire. We hurried to the shop and saw a fire truck entering our yard about 6:12 p.m. Fire Fighters wouldn't wait any longer, so they broke the lock on the gate. Fire personnel immediately engaged the fire on the north side of our Office Building where the HVAC unit located. I open the building so fire personnel would gain entry. I stood by while the flames were extinguished.

Arnold Billie, volunteer fire chief for McKinley County spoke to me. He said Ethel from the School saw flames coming from the building, while driving back from the High School. She stopped by Arnold's house at the Chapter Compound. When Arnold walked out he said flames were shooting thru the roof of our office building. He immediately sent his wife Racheal to go up to my house, so I could open the gate to the yard. This was close to 6 p.m. (about 5:50p.m.)

Arnold Billie deployed his volunteer fire personnel that instant. They doused the flame thereafter about 6:30 p.m. I shut off the water to the building and electricity.

Fire personnel waited around for hotspots flare-ups till 8:20 p.m. and did their mop up. At this time I talked with Officer Michael Peshlaskai from Crownpoint District. His Phone number is (505)786-2056. He

asked me who the last one was out to lock up, if the building had any issues, whether it is electrical, heating, etc... He ordered me not to enter the building in the morning until an investigator got there.

November 19, 2015 8:00a.m. called Donald Daswood, Eastern Navajo Agency Department of Water Resources Supervisor but was on leave. Talked with Cheryl Antone, Office Assistant explained the fire, damage and that we were waiting on for the investigator. I also called Mr. Najam H. Tariq, Branch Director for water Resources/ Technical, Construction & Operations Branch in Fort Defiance, Arizona. He would call a meeting to see how they would respond. I called on my cell phone from entrance to Pueblo Pintado canyon, White Horse Lake.

9:30a.m. Met with Christopher Tsosie, Criminal Investigator from Crownpoint District. He took photos outside and inside the building. Case number for this incident is 03-15-023892. It is safe to say, Officer Tsosie concluded the fire was started by the HVAC unit. They advised us not to enter the building until Navajo Nation Department of Risk Management and Navajo Nation Department of Property personnel inspect the building.

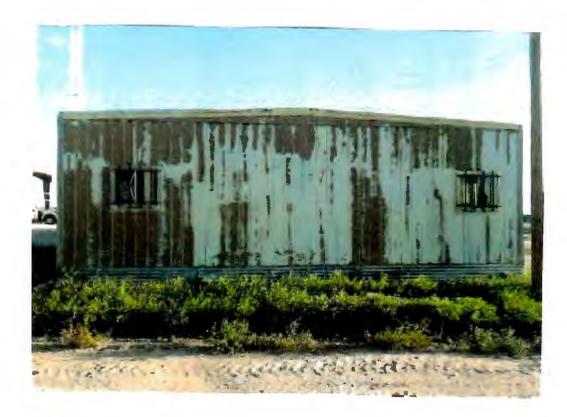

At this point our main concern is renovating our old office so service can continue for the Navajo People.

Many Farms Irrigation Office









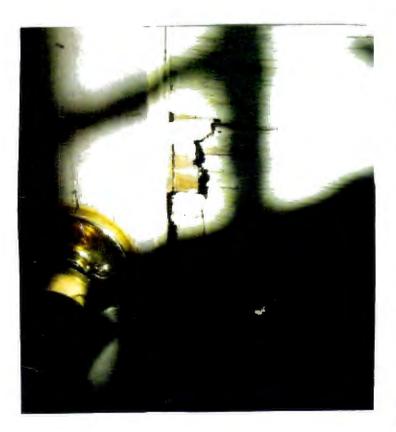


Ganado/Burnside Field Office

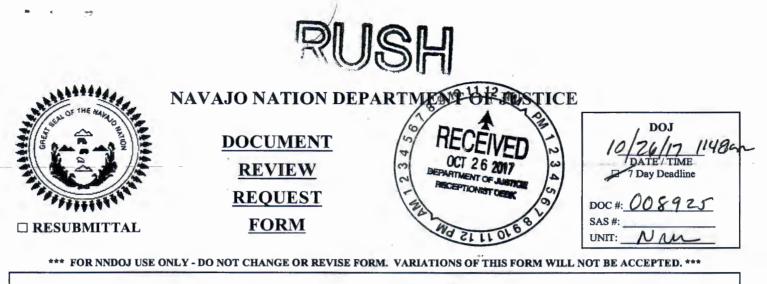
