# RESOLUTION OF THE NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

#### 23RD NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL - FIRST YEAR, 2015

#### AN ACTION

NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE: ORDER AND LAW AND RELATING TO WITH THE NAVAJO NATION PRESIDENT'S CONCURRING ACCEPTANCE FROM NAVAJO COUNTY ON BEHALF OF THE NAVAJO NATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY; AND DIRECTING THE NAVAJO POLICE DEPARTMENT TO RECORD THE DONATION WITH THE ETHICS AND RULES OFFICE AND NAVAJO NATION PROPERTY

#### BE IT ENACTED:

#### SECTION ONE. FINDINGS:

- A. The Navajo Nation Council gave the Navajo Nation President authorization to accept or decline property gifts to the Navajo Nation with the Naabik'íyáti Committee's concurrence. 2 N.N.C. § 1010 (2009) see also CJA-03-13, section 5, 30 (2013).
- B. "...the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council shall introduce [the proposed legislation] into the legislative process by assigning [the proposed legislation] to the respective oversight committee of the Navajo Nation Council having authority over the matters for proper consideration..." 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A) (5) (2012) see also CJA-03-13.
- C. The Navajo Nation Council gave the Law and Order Committee oversight over the Division of Public Safety. 2 N.N.C. § 601 (C) (1) (2012) see also CJA-03-13.
- D. The Department of Public Safety received documentation supporting the acceptance of two dual purpose canines, EXHIBIT A.
- E. Accepting the donation of two dual purpose canines for the Navajo Police Department's use is in the Navajo Nation's best interest.

#### SECTION TWO. ACCEPTANCE:

- A. The Navajo Nation concurs with the Navajo Nation President's acceptance of two dual purpose trained canines, EXHIBIT B.
- B. The Navajo Nation directs the Navajo Police Department to record the receipt of two dual purpose trained canines with the Ethics and Rules Office as required by 2 N.N.C. § 1012 (2009).
- C. The Navajo Nation directs the Navajo Police Department to record the receipt of two dual purpose trained canines with Navajo Nation Property as required by 2 N.N.C. § 1010 (2009).

You can pick up dogs on September 11 or 12<sup>th</sup> for a week of <u>bonding</u> with their new handlers. No training will occur that week only the assigned dog with his new handler, will make friends.

Attached is the training schedule working four ten schedule with three days off. Lots of nights due to heat problems.

The lesson plan is only <u>one of two</u> in AZ that is approved by AZ POST. I obtained that approval while at Maricopa SO and at the AZ Department of Corrections the past 30 years. <u>Waddell Kennels</u> is now approved by AZ POST to teach our 4 week course (160 hrs.). Your Handlers will receive 160 hrs. of credit with AZ POST, <u>AZ POST Confirmation Number 15-206</u>. The canines bought have been previously trained by Mark and me, and your staff will be going through a "Basic K-9 Handler Course" insuring your teams long term success.

Additional agency canine teams attending this canine handler course are Phoenix PD, Tempe PD, Pinole PD CA., and hopefully AZ Juvenile Corrections.

Upon the completion of the Waddell Kennel "Basic K-9 Handler Course" handlers will receive a completion certificate, AZ POST official recognition form for 160 hrs. of training (15-206), NPCA and/or NNDDA National certification, and a six month canine health warrantee.
