**Section One. Authority**

1. The Resources and Development Committee exercises authority over chapters of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 501(C)(1).
2. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council exercises authority over budgeting, appropriation, investment and management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. § 301 (B)(2).
3. Council Resolution CAP-35-18 provides, "[a] chapter project, powerline, or waterline project may be changed, including the year funded, or added to Exhibits A through E with the concurrence of the Delegate representing the chapter's Council District and the approvals of the Resources and Development Committee and Budget and Finance Committee, as long as such project has been certified as construction-ready by CPMD or NTUA and the total Síhasin Funding for the District does not exceed \$4,166,666.67."

1       **Section Two. Findings**

2       A. The Navajo Nation Council adopted Council Resolution CAP-35-18, "Adopting  
3       the Sihasin Fund Powerline and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan Pursuant to  
4       CD-68-14, as Amended by CJA-03-18, and 12 N.N.C. §§ 2501-2508, as Amended;  
5       Waiving 12 N.N.C. §§ 810 (F), 820 (I) and (M) and 860 (C) Relating to the Capital  
6       Budget and Capital Improvement Process" on April 17, 2018.

7       B. Ts'ah Bii Kin (Inscription House) Chapter Projects are listed in CAP-35-18 at  
8       Exhibit B, Project Number 10, Exhibit D, Project Number 97, and Exhibit D,  
9       Project Number 98. Exhibit B and D of CAP-35-18 are attached as **Exhibit 2**.

10      C. Ts'ah Bii Kin (Inscription House) Chapter submitted a CAP-35-18 Sihasin Project  
11      Amendment Certification form, which is attached as **Exhibit 1**.

12      D. The CAP-35-18 Sihasin Project Amendment Certification form, **Exhibit 1**,  
13      indicates changes to be made to CAP-35-18: Exhibit B, Project Number 10;  
14      Exhibit D, Project Number 97; and Exhibit D, Project Number 98 regarding the


Pursuant to Navajo Nation Legislation Resolution No. Cap-35-18, The Navajo Nation Council authorized \$661,666.68 to Ts'ah Bii Kin Chapter Powerline Project (Project Type: Design /Construction). There are 32 homes that will be receiving electricity. However, the project is considered a "Short Fall" of \$62,459.22 according to NTUA. The Design part is completed and is now in the Construction- Ready.

Capital Projects Management Department indicated on the Change Form in amount of \$64,000.00 (transfer from CAP-35-18, Exhibit D, Project No. 97 – Solid Waste Transfer Station) as a precaution to Cost Adjustment. Ts'ah Bii Kin is ready for construction therefore, NTUA requires full payment upfront to begin the powerline project construction portion of the project.

Base on the aforementioned reason, the CPMD requests the Resources Development Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee to support and approve the Project Change Process and Procedures for CAP-35-18, Exhibit B, Project No. 10. This Project Change Process will allow the project to step out of the "Short Fall" statues and continue to move forward to completing the 100% Construction-Ready. After the completion, the total CAP-35-18 funding for the Council District does not exceed \$4,166,666.67.

2. Pursuant to N.N.C., Section 1 (B), the Ts'ah Bii Kin Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community, make appropriate corrections when necessary, and provide recommendations to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate action(s); and
3. The Navajo Nation Council (NNC), through Legislation No. CAP35-18 (Sihasin Legislation), adopted the Sihasin Fund Powerline and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan, and;
4. The Sihasin Legislation divided the projects into three (3) projects and Ts'ah Bii Kin has a House Wiring Project awarded to Todineeshzee' Plumbing and Electric; also a Powerline Project with NTUA, and;
5. The Sihasin Legislation provides that funds for Ts'ah Bii Kin will be allocated to and administered by CPMD
6. The Ts'ah Bii Kin Chapter has determined that it is in the best interest of the community to recommend this approval, and;
7. Ts'ah Bii Kin is ready for construction and will need full payment upfront to begin the Powerline Project portion of the Project.


SUBJECT: Change Form - Sihasin Project Amendment Certification

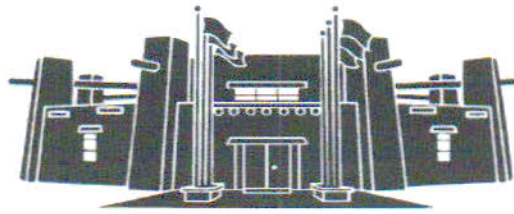

As requested, I have prepared the above-referenced proposed resolution and associated legislative summary sheet pursuant to your request for legislative drafting. Based on existing law and review of documents submitted, the resolution as drafted is legally sufficient. As with any action of government however, it can be subject to review by the courts in the event of proper challenge. Please ensure that this particular resolution request is precisely what you want. You are encouraged to review the proposed resolution to ensure that it is drafted to your satisfaction.

The Office of Legislative Counsel confirms the appropriate standing committee(s) based on the standing committees powers outlined in 2 N.N.C. §§301, 401, 501, 601 and 701. Nevertheless, "the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council shall introduce [the proposed resolution] into the legislative process by assigning it to the respective oversight committee(s) of the Navajo Nation Council having authority over the matters for proper consideration." 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(5).
