BE IT ENACTED:

Section One. Authority

- A. The Health, Education, and Human Services Committee is a Standing Committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 400 (A).
- B. Health, Education, and Human Services Committee (HEHSC) has oversight authority over the Division of Human Resources. Navajo Nation TV & Film is within the Division of Human Resources. 2 N.N.C. § 401(C)(1).
- C. The Budget and Finance Committee is a Standing Committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 300(A).
- D. The Budget and Finance Committee has the power "[t]o approve Fund Management Plans pursuant to the recommendations of the appropriate oversight committee and affected Division or Branch." 2 N.N.C. § 301(B)(14).
- E. The Budget and Finance Committee has approved the Eligibility Criteria for the Expenditure of Revenues Generated by Programs and Departments. Budget and Finance Committee Resolution, BFN-187-03.


Section Two. Findings

- A. Navajo Nation TV & Film submitted an expenditure plan pursuant to BFN-187-03. The expenditure plan is attached as **Exhibit A**.
- B. A program meets the purpose for an expenditure plan where a program or department collects revenue through the collection of fees for goods or services and wishes to expend the revenues collected, but is ineligible for a special revenue fund management plan,
- C. Navajo Nation TV & Film was previously known as the Office of Broadcast Services. The name was changed to Navajo Nation TV & Film in the current plan of operation approved by HEHSC in 2018. See HEHSC Resolution, HEHSCJN-11-18, attached as **Exhibit B**.
- D. Navajo Nation TV & Film ("NNTVF") charges fees for services provided. These fees include permit fees, equipment rental, production assistance, location scouting, talent registration fee, media sales, site-colocation, and lease fees, media workshops, and underwriting.
- E. The Executive Official Review documents are attached as **Exhibit B.** All reviewers noted the NNTVF Expenditure Plan is sufficient.

Section Three. Approval

The Navajo Nation hereby approves NNTVF's Expenditure Plan, which is attached as **Exhibit A**.

<u>Division of Human Resources</u> <u>Navajo Nation TV & Film (NNTVF)</u> Expenditure Plan



This authorizes the NNTVF to receive, manage and expend funds generated by the activities of NNTVF and shall be entrusted to the authorized personnel, as delegated by the Division Director of Human Resources.

I. ESTABLISHMENT

This hereby establishes the "Navajo Nation TV and Film – Expenditure Plan" (114003) for use by NNTVF as Expenditure of Revenues generated by program, pursuant to Resolution No: BFN-187-03 and No: HEHSC-11-18.

The Health, Education and Human Services Committee of the Navajo Nation Council shall provide legislative oversight, pursuant to 2 NNC § 401 (C) (1).

II. PURPOSE

The Navajo Nation TV and Film (NNTVF) – Expenditure Plan regulates revenue produced by NNTVF, establishes sound financial administration including accountability principles, prevent the risk of financial negligence and protects the assets of the Navajo Nation.

III. GENERATION OF REVENUES

A. Funding Sources

- a) Permit Fees
- b) Equipment Rental and/or Property Rental
- c) Production Assistance
- d) Location Scouting
- e) Talent Registration Fee
- f) Media Sales
- g) Site-Co location and Lease fees

IV. FUND MANAGEMENT / ACTIVITIES

A. Rate-Setting Method

The fees set by the NNTVF for television, film and media production services are comparable to industry standard rates.

The expenditure and revenue will comply with Navajo Nation Law; including Navajo Nation Sales Tax, Navajo Business Opportunity Act, and Appropriations Act.

C. Budgeting

1. Budget Requirement

- a. The revenues generated will be credited to the NNTV & F's general fund budget upon receipt by the Office of the Controller Cashier's Section.
- b. NNTV & F would need to submit a projected revenues schedule for the upcoming respective Fiscal Year. This schedule should show the revenue sources and projected number of transactions with each, any other insight into the projection should also be included in the narrative.
- c. The recommended revenue projection will be generated, reviewed and sent to the program as well as the Office of Management and Budget from General Accounting Section.
- d. Revenues generated cannot be expended on or allocated to uses other than those specified in the Fund Management Plan.

2. Expenditure of Funds

Expenditures from this fund shall be budgeted annually in accordance with established Navajo Nation Budget Policies and Procedures:

- a. Personnel and Benefits (1000)
- b. Travel Expenses (3000) Necessary travel pertaining to NNTVF
- c. Office Supplies (4000)
- d. Repairs/Maintenance (6000) Required maintenance of building, property, and equipment
- e. Contractual Services (6500)
- f. Capital Outlay (9000)

3. Program Management

NNTVF shall have the authority and responsibility to use the funds in accordance with the approved Fund Management Plan.

4. Periodic Review Request

All fees, charges and projected revenue will be subject to annual review with the Navajo Nation Office of the Controller. All unexpended revenue shall revert to the Navajo Nation General Funds at the end of each fiscal year.

The revenues generated shall be reconciled and reported annually as part of the overall accountability of funds.

V. EFFECTIVE DATE

The Fund Management Plan shall be effective upon approval by the Health, Education, and Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee (pursuant to CAP-10-11 §300) of the Navaio Nation Council.

VI. ADMENDMENTS

This Fund Management Plan may be amended from time to time by the Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council upon recommendation of the Health, Education, and Human Services Committee of the Navajo Nation Council as appropriate.

The Office of Management and Budget reviewed above subject Section 164 Document according to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (M) and the following are noted on the Office of Broadcast Services Fund Management Plan proposal:

- Per 2 NNC §165 (A) "All resolutions proposing new laws or amendments of laws are legislation and shall clearly indicate new language by underscoring the new language and deletion by overstrike and shall refer to appropriate Navajo Nation Code Titles and Sections."
- 2. The 164 document review sheet is titled Office of Broadcast Services; however the proposal has *Division of Human Resources Navajo Nation TV & Film Fund Management Plan*. Is the Fund Management Plan proposal for Office of Broadcast Services and/or Division of Human Resources? This needs further clarification.
- 3. I. Establishment states "There is hereby established the Navajo Nation TV, Film and Media Production Special Revenue Fund Account" (114003) for the use by the Navajo Nation TV and Film, Division of Human Resources." Should this language be "There is hereby established the Office of Broadcast Services, Special Revenue Fund Account:" (114003) for use by the Navajo Nation Office of Broadcast Services within Division of Human Resources."
- 4. Recommend that the Office of Broadcast Services amend their plan of operation including renaming the program the "Navajo Nation TV & Film." Then this proposal would place the definition under the "Purpose of Navajo Nation TV & Film" section. This will clarify the detailed description of the purpose, authorities, and responsibilities of the program. This will also rescind all of the prior programs' plan of operation resolution. The latest that OMB has and should be amended is HEHSCAU-18-14. The program is still called Office of Broadcast Services BU#114003.



- 5. Page 5, f. reads "Authorization for expenditures shall be entrusted to the authorized personnel with the Office of Broadcast Services/Navajo Film Office as delegated by the Executive Director, Division of Human Services." This needs clarification. The intend of this proposal is the Office of Broadcast Services' Fund Management Plan is to authorize the program to receive, manage and disburse funds generated by revenue producing activities of the OBS.
- 6. V. Effective Date reads "The effective date of the fund management plan herein shall be effective upon approval of the Health, Education, and Human Services Committee. Pursuant to CAP-10-11 §300 Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council has the authority to approve Fund Management Plans recommended of the appropriate oversight committee.
- 7. OMB recommends the above issues and questions be addressed.



Navajo Nation TV & Film PLAN OF OPERATION

I. ESTABLISHMENT

There is hereby established the Navajo Nation TV & Film (NNTVF) within the Division of Human Resources of the Executive Branch of the Navajo Nation Government.

II. OBJECTIVES

•

- A. Navajo Nation TV and Film (NNTVF) shall:
 - 1. Provide television (tv), film, and media services on the Navajo Nation;
 - 2. Provide tv, film and media workshops to promote career opportunities and training;
 - 3. Create policies and procedures regarding tv, film and media;
 - 4. Advocate, coordinate and provide assistance in television, film, and media relations to the Navajo Nation;
 - 5. Collect and safeguard historic media pertaining to Navajo culture, traditions and stories:
 - 6. Provide guidance on Navajo culture and authenticity;
 - 7. Seek expansion and improvement opportunities in tv, filming and media services;
 - 8. Advocate for equitable partnership and investment in tv, film and media industry; this may include co-production, production (e.g. location scouting, casting calls, production assistance, crew, etc.) and the use of Navajo Nation Program and Services:
 - 9. Produce public information for distribution through various media outlets;
 - 10. Create tv programming with an emphasis on Navajo language, culture and interest;
 - 11. Produce creative media content to preserve and document the perspectives, experience, and voices of the Navajo community;
 - 12. Create programs in partnership with local community colleges, to provide opportunities for Native youth to gain experience in production and journalism;
 - 13. Explore innovative and viable media markets for the Navajo Nation;
 - 14. Create and implement a Fund Management Plan.

III. STAFFING AND ORGANIZATION

- A. Staffing
 - 1. The NNTVF Program Manager I shall have responsibility to supervise the overall function of the program including fiscal management, personnel, property, internal policies, etc., and on a case by case basis may delegate authority;
 - 2. The NNTVF Program Manager I under the general direction and guidance of the Division Director of the Division of Human Resources;

SION

- 3. The Program Manager shall be authorized or recommend other professional, technical, specialized and clerical positions as needed to carry out the duties and responsibilities stated herein; additional positions shall be acquired in accordance with applicable personnel policies and procedures and applicable budget rules established for conducting the annual Navajo Nation budget process.
- All personnel shall be selected, employed, supervised and terminated pursuant to and in accordance with the Navajo Nation Personnel Policy Manual and other applicable laws and regulations;
- 5. Build a positive environment to enhance production that is essential to the NNTVF and clients.

B. Organization

1. The organizational chart for the NNTVF is attached as "Exhibit A" herein.

IV - RESPONSIBILITY AND AUTHORITY

- 1. Implement and/or upgrade infrastructure in accordance with applicable rules and regulations;
- 2. Promote the use of modern technology and shift the program to a revenue-producing platform;
- 3. Develop and administer procedures for film and photography permits on the Navajo Nation;
- 4. Maintain security and accountability of program property;
- 5. To broadcast emergency alerts though the Emergency Alert System (EAS) in coordination with the Navajo Department of Emergency Management (NDEM);
- 6. Create Agreement(s) to protect tribal interest and sovereignty with the assistance and approval of the Navajo Department of Justice (NDOJ).

V. LEGISLATIVE OVERSIGHT

Legislative oversight for the operations of the NNTVF shall be provided by the Health, Education and Human Services Committee of the Navajo Nation Council.



II. PURPOSE

The Navajo Nation TV and Film (NNTVF) - Fund Management Plan regulates revenue produced by NNTVF, establishes sound financial administration including accountability principles, prevent the risk of financial negligence and protects the assets of the Navajo Nation.

IV. FUND MANAGEMENT / ACTIVITIES

The fees set by the NNTVF for television, film and media production services are comparable to industry standard rates.

The expenditure and revenue will comply with Navajo Nation Law; including Navajo Nation Sales Tax, Navaio Business Opportunity Act, and Appropriations Act.

C. Budgeting

1. Budget Requirement

- a. The revenues generated will be credited to the NNTV & F's general fund budget upon receipt by the Office of the Controller Cashier's Section.
- b. NNTV & F would need to submit a projected revenues schedule for the upcoming respective Fiscal Year. This schedule should show the revenue sources and projected number of transactions with each, any other insight into the projection should also be included in the narrative.
- c. The recommended revenue projection will be generated, reviewed and sent to the program as well as the Office of Management and Budget from General **Accounting Section.**
- d. Revenues generated cannot be expended on or allocated to uses other than those specified in the Fund Management Plan.

2. Expenditure of Funds

Expenditures from this fund shall be budgeted annually in accordance with established **Navajo Nation Budget Policies and Procedures:**

- a. Personnel and Benefits (1000)
- b. Travel Expenses (3000) Necessary travel pertaining to NNTVF
- c. Office Supplies (4000)
- d. Repairs/Maintenance (6000) Required maintenance of building, property, and equipment
- e. Contractual Services (6500)
- f. Capital Outlay (9000)

3. Program Management

NNTVF shall have the authority and responsibility to use the funds in accordance with the approved Fund Management Plan.

4. Periodic Review Request

All fees, charges and projected revenue will be subject to annual review with the Navajo Nation Office of the Controller. All unexpended revenue shall revert to the Navajo Nation General Funds at the end of each fiscal year.

The revenues generated shall be reconciled and reported annually as part of the overall accountability of funds.

V. EFFECTIVE DATE

The Fund Management Plan shall be effective upon approval by the Health, Education, and Human Services Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee (pursuant to CAP-10-11 §300) of the **Navajo Nation Council.**

VI. ADMENDMENTS

This Fund Management Plan may be amended from time to time by the Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council upon recommendation of the Health, Education, and Human Services Committee of the Navajo Nation Council as appropriate.
