COMMITTEES; APPROVING A CHANGE IN PROJECT SCOPE IN RESOLUTION
CAP-35-18; AMENDING THE PROJECT SCOPE TO ADD DESIGN FOR THE
TSE'II'AHÍ (STANDING ROCK) HEADSTART BUILDING PROJECT

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Resources and Development Committee exercises authority over chapters of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. 501(C)(1).
- B. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council exercises authority over budgeting, appropriation, investment and management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. § 301(B)(2).
- C. Council Resolution CAP-35-18 provides, "[a] chapter project, powerline, or waterline project may be changed, including the year funded, or added to Exhibits A through E with the concurrence of the Delegate representing the chapter's Council District and the approvals of the Resources and Development Committee and Budget and Finance Committee, as long as such project has been certified as construction-ready by CPMD or NTUA and the total Síhasin Funding for the District does not exceed \$4,166,666.67"

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. The Navajo Nation Council adopted Council Resolution CAP-35-18, "Adopting the Síhasin Fund Powerline and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan Pursuant to CD-68-14, as Amended by CJA-03-18, and 12 N.N.C. §§ 2501-2508, as Amended; Waiving 12 N.N.C. §§ 810(F), 820(I) and (M) and

860(C) Relating to the Capital Budget and Capital Improvement Process" on April 17, 2018.

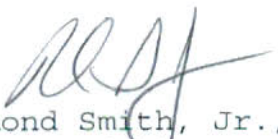
- B. Tse'Ii'Ahi' (Standing Rock) Chapter submitted a CAP-35-18 Project Change Form to the Capital Project Management Department which has been reviewed and is attached as **Exhibit A**. CPMD has provided a Letter of Certification providing the status of the Tse'Ii'Ahi' Head Start Building Project and is attached as **Exhibit C**.
- C. The Project Change Form indicated that the Tse'Ii'Ahi' Chapter is amending the project scope by adding "design" to the Tse'Ii'Ahi' Head Start Building project plan. For reference, the Tse'Ii'Ahi' Head Start Building is included in Exhibit D, Project 112 of CAP-35-18.
- D. Additional information regarding the Tse'Ii'Ahi' Head Start Building is attached as **Exhibit B**.

SECTION THREE. APPROVAL

The Navajo Nation hereby approves an amendment in the project scope by adding "design" to the plan for the Tse'Ii'Ahi' Head Start Building.

The Standing Rock Chapter has been working on securing funds the past few years for a new Head Start Facility. The following documents were completed and obtained, Land users consent, legal survey, archeological and biological studies, and clearances have been completed. The Chapter has acquired 164 (B) an AIA Contract between the Navajo Nation and Indigenous Design Studio + Architecture (IDSA), therefore this deem project/Construction ready.

Standing Rock Chapter has secured funding for the design and construction. Construction funds were secured through the Navajo Nation as part of the 1st Year Sihasin Funds and Chapter Capital Projects Expenditure Plan.

During the project, a Construction Administration of the Project will be required during the start of construction, and the results require IDS+ Architects services. These facts created a change in scope of work resulting to the need for additional design funds. Therefore, we request for "Design" to be added to the expenditure plan for the project and that the project remains in the 1st Year of Sihasin Funds. The approval of this legislation will continue the Navajo Nation to modify the current contract and bring the project to 100% complete for design of construction Administration (CA) services.


The Chapter is respectfully requesting the Resources Development Committee, Budget and Finance Committee and Sihasin sub-committee to process and have the Architecture firm complete this project by approving the requested change in Legislation. We look forward to working with IDS+ Architecture, and appreciate all the hard work put into this project.
