TITLE OF RESOLUTION: AN ACTION RELATING TO BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE AND THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$45,000 FOR OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE NAVAJO-HOPI LAND COMMISSION OFFICE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015

PURPOSE: This resolution, if approved, will approve supplemental funding to the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission office to provide operating funds for the remaining months of Fiscal Year 2015 due to a budget shortfall.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committee. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each committee member to review the proposed resolution in detail.

18	SECTION 1. FINDINGS	
19	A. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (L), "[t]he Navajo Nation Council may adopt and	
20	approve supplemental appropriations to the Annual Comprehensive Budget during	
21	the fiscal year. Supplemental appropriations of General Funds within the current	
22	fiscal year are permitted, if and when additional sources of revenues above and	
23	beyond the initial or current revenue projections are projected and which are also in	
24	excess of the reserve amount set forth at § 820(J)."	
25	B. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(9), a proposed resolution that requires final action by	
26	the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee before it	
27	is heard by the Navajo Nation Council.	
28	C. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 300 (C)(1)(3) and (4) the Budget and Finance Committee is	
29	authorized to recommend adoption of resolutions related to the expenditure of the	
30	Nation's financial resources.	

- D. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 856, [t]here shall be a Navajo-Hopi Land Commission Office under the direction of the President of the Navajo Nation.
- E. The Navajo-Hopi Land Commission Office is experiencing a funding shortage in the Fiscal Year 2015 operating budget and requires supplemental funding to carry out the responsibilities and duties of the Office. Budget Forms attached as Exhibit A.
- F. The Title 12 Finance Act Supplemental Appropriation requirements include:
 - 1. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(M), all requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget ("OMB") for budget impact analysis. Attached as Exhibit B.
 - Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(M), when the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections, supplemental appropriations may be allocated by the Navajo Nation Council. Attached as Exhibit C.
- G. The Navajo Nation finds it in the best interest to approve Supplemental Appropriation for the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission Office.

SECTION 2. APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$45,000 FOR THE NAVAJO-HOPI LAND COMMISSION OFFICE

- A. The Navajo Nation Council, having received certification by the Office of the Controller of the availability of certain funds from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance (UUFB) for supplemental appropriation hereby approves the supplemental appropriation of \$45,000 for the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission Office for Fiscal Year 2015, as further described in budget documents attached.
- B. This supplemental appropriation of \$45,000 shall be to Business Unit Number 103003 and from that amount of funds that exceeds the minimum fund balance of the UUFB.

PART II. REASON FOR REQUEST AND STATEMENT OF NEED:

The NHLCO is experiencing a funding shortage in its travel and operating costs for the remaining four months of Fiscal Year 2015. The newly appointed NHLCO Executive Director and staff do not have funding left in the Fiscal Year 2015 operating budget to continue carrying out the responsibilities and duties of the NHLCO.

PART III. SCOPE OF WORK/METHODOLOGY

The Executive Director will be traveling to Twin Arrows Casino, Phoenix, AZ, Farmington, NM, Albuquerque, NM and Washington, D.C. to advise and seek support from elected officials on the proposed revisions to the Navajo Technical Amendment Act of 2014 (H.R. 5039). Additional travel is schedule to attend meetings regarding the following pending projects: (1) purchase of Red Barn Property; (2) purchase of Cosnino Property; (3) Paragon Renewable Energy Development Project; and (4) Relocatee Fund Management Plan. Additional meetings are scheduled for visitations with the nine (9) former Berinett Freeze chapters, fourteen (14) NPL chapters, and special interest groups located in Winslow, AZ, Tuba City, AZ, Coppermine, AZ and Phoenix, AZ. Potential travel plans to San Francisco, CA may be scheduled for the Exective Director to attend the Ninth Circuit court mandated mediation on HPL religious rights/land dispute matter. From time to time, the Executive Director will be requested to attend the Navajo-Hopi Land Commission (NHLC) meetings scheduled in different locations. The operating budget set aside for Fiscal Year 2015 had to be transferred to cover the remaining travel budget of the former Executive Director. This transfer left a deficit in both the operating and travel budgets of the NHLCO for the remaining four months of the Fiscal Year 2015.

The Office of Management and Budget reviewed the above subject 164 document and does not find any significant deviations from the budget instructions regarding completion of budget forms or other instructions, except the following:

- 1. All budgeted amounts should be rounded to the nearest dollar on Budget Form 1, Part III. and all budget data entries in the object codes (especially in the amounts in Column (C) of Part II.) on Budget Form 4s.
- 2. The attached YTD budget Status report shows expenditure levels for each budgeted object code and it shows that significant over-spending is occurring in the operating expense portion (particularly the travel expenses exceeding that budget by \$15,756.10 YTD) of the FY 2015 overall budget with the balance from the personnel line item covering the overall over-spending of \$13,260.40. The balance not spend to-date in the personnel budget cannot be transferred to cover costs in the rest of the budget. The program will definitely need additional funds in operating cost of \$13,260 for YTD over-expenditures in operating cost plus expenses anticipated the rest of the fiscal year.

The Section 164 Review Form in Section 164 (A) will be marked insufficient at this time until the forms are corrected.


