

RESOLUTION OF THE
NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' STANDING COMMITTEE
25th NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL -- First Year, 2023

AN ACTION RELATING TO THE NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE; CONCURRING WITH THE NAVAJO NATION PRESIDENT TO ACCEPT A DONATION OF \$2,000.00 FROM WILLIAMS J. BARTLEY AND A DONATION OF \$2,000.00 FROM MOZE AND MARY MEEKER TO THE OFFICE OF NAVAJO NATION SCHOLARSHIP AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR THE BENEFIT OF NAVAJO STUDENTS PURSUING POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Navajo Nation established the Naabik'íyáti' Committee as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 700(A).
- B. The President of the Navajo Nation shall, for and on behalf of the Navajo Nation, accept or decline gifts of property, provided that any such acceptance or refusal of a gift of an estimated value in excess of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) shall be with the concurrence of the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. § 1010.
- C. All public officials, elected and non-elected, of the Navajo Nation receiving gifts, whether intended as a gift to the official or to the Navajo Nation, shall record or cause to be recorded such gift with the Ethics and Rules Office." 2 N.N.C. § 1012.

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. The Office of Navajo Nation Scholarship and Financial Assistance ("ONNSFA") received a donation in the amount of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) from Edward D. Jones & Company on behalf of William J. Bartley.
- B. The President of the Navajo Nation issued a letter to the Investment Officer in acceptance of the donation and gratitude for the generous contribution of scholarship funds to the Navajo Nation from William J. Bartley, attached as Exhibit A.
- C. ONNSFA also received a donation in the amount of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) from Moze and Mary Meeker for the scholarship fund.

- D. The President of the Navajo Nation issued a letter to Moze and Mary Meeker in acceptance of the donation and gratitude for the generous contribution of scholarship funds to the Navajo Nation, attached as **Exhibit B**.
- E. All appropriate entities within the Executive Branch reviewed and subsequently deemed it legally sufficient to accept the donations from William J. Bartley and from Moze and Mary Meeker. **Exhibit C**.

SECTION THREE. APPROVAL

- A. The Naabik'íyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby concurs with the President of the Navajo Nation to accept the donations of funds from William J. Bartley and Moze and Mary Meeker to the Office of Navajo Nation Scholarship and Financial Assistance for the benefit of Navajo students pursuing higher education or vocational education.
- B. The Naabik'íyáti' Committee further directs that the funds be deposited as Fiscal Year 2023 funds in Business Unit 509007.
- C. The Office of Navajo Nation Scholarship and Financial Assistance shall record the receipt of the donation with the Ethics and Rules Office pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 1012.

SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Action shall become effective pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 189(A).

CERTIFICATION

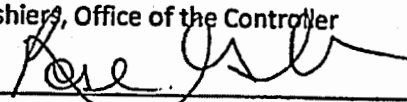
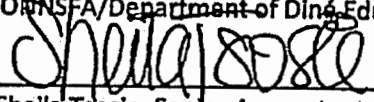

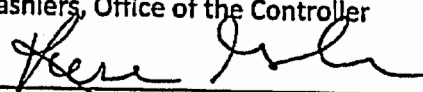
