BE IT ENACTED:

Section One. Findings

A. Section 1.01 of the By-Laws of the Diné Development Corporation states - "As the sole shareholder, the Navajo Nation's shares in the Corporation will be exercised by five (5) 'shareholder representatives' composed of one member from each of the five (5) standing committees of the Navajo Nation Council or their successor committees...."

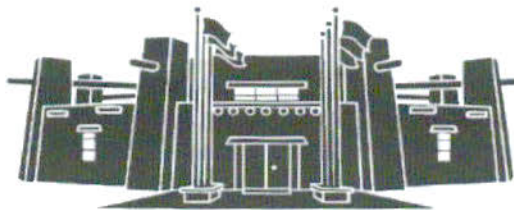
B. The Law and Order Committee is a committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 600.

Section Two. Appointing Shareholder Representative

The Law and Order Committee hereby appoints _____, a member of the committee, as shareholder representative to the Diné Development Corporation.

1 **Section Three. Effective date of appointments; duration**

2 The appointment made herein shall become effective upon adoption of this resolution
3 by the Committee. The terms of the appointments shall be consistent with Navajo Nation
4 law and governing documents of the corporation to which the appointment is made.
