## AN ACTION

RELATING TO RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT AND BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEES; APPROVING A PROJECT CHANGE IN RESOLUTION CAP-35-18; APPROVING A CHANGE IN PROJECT DESCRIPTION FOR INDIAN WELLS CHAPTER

## BE IT ENACTED:

## SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Resources and Development Committee exercises authority over chapters of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. \$ 501(C)(1).
- B. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council exercises authority over budgeting, appropriation, investment and management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. § 301(B)(2).
- C. Council Resolution CAP-35-18 provides, "[a] chapter projects, powerline, or waterline project may be changed, including the year funded, or added to Exhibits A through E with the concurrence of the Delegate representing the chapter's Council District and the approvals of the Resources and Development Committee and Budget and Finance Committee, as long as such project has been certified as construction-ready by CPMD or NTUA and the total Sihasin Funding for the District does not exceed \$4,166,666.67."

## SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

A. The Navajo Nation Council adopted Council Resolution CAP-35-18, "Adopting the Sihasin Fund Powerline and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan Pursuant to CD-68-14, as Amended by CJA-03-18, and 12 N.N.C. §\$ 2501-2508, as Amended; Waiving 12 N.N.C. §\$ 810(F), 820(I) and (M) and 860(C)

Relating to the Capital Budget and Capital Improvement Process" on April 17, 2018.

- B. Indian Wells Chapter requests to change the approved funding year in CAP-35-18 to delete Indian Well 10 Commercial Site Development Planning from year one funding in project D-107 and to replace it with Indian Well 10 Commercial Site Development Planning (plan, design, and construction). The project funding of \$200,000 will remain in year one.
- C. The Sihasin Project Amendment Certification, attached as Exhibit A, has been signed by the Delegate representing the chapter's council district as required by CAP-35-18, section 4, paragraph C.
- D. The Capital Projects Management Department, through its signature in section IV of **Exhibit A**, has indicated the project is construction ready. Also, while not a requirement pursuant to CAP-35-18, Indian Wells Chapter has indicated its support of this request in Indian Wells Chapter Resolution, IWC-20-135, attached as **Exhibit B**.

## SECTION THREE. APPROVAL

The Navajo Nation hereby approves the project change requested by Indian Wells Chapter in accordance with **Exhibit A**.

Supporting and Approving the Granting of Utility Easement within the Indian Wells Chapter Withdrawn 25.07± Acres Business/Commercial Development Site and Requesting the Division of Community Development, Capital Projects Management Department, to Begin the Process for Encumbering Sihasin Funds, Business Unit C01695, for Electric Power Line Extension and Waterline Extension Construction

Resolution #IWC-20-135

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The Indian Wells Chapter is a recognized Chapter of the Navajo Nation government, vested with certain authority and responsibilities to consider and act on matters of local concern that are in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Chapter members and residents; and
- 2. Pursuant to Title 26 N.N.C., Navajo Nation Local Governance Act, the Navajo Nation Council delegates to Chapters governmental authority with respect to local matters consistent with Navajo Nation laws, including custom and traditions, to make decisions over local matters, and to govern with responsibility and accountability to the local citizens; and
- 3. In order to continue the site development of the Chapter's withdrawn twenty-five (25±) acres business/commercial development zone along Navajo Route 6, the Indian Wells Chapter has engaged and is collaborating with Navajo Tribal Utility Authority (NTUA) to plan out and design the electric and water infrastructure for the economic development zone; and
- 4. A preliminary assessment of the proposed utility infrastructure development determined that a utility easement needs to be granted by the Indian Wells Chapter in order for NTUA to construct the electric and water line extensions from the existing electric power line and water line, attached hereto as Exhibit A; and
- 5. A preliminary construction cost estimate was provided by NTUA for the electric line extension \$128,597.18, which is contingent upon further discussion with the proposed tenant, Red Mesa Trading, attached hereto as Exhibit B; and
- 6. It is planned that the Sihasin funds allocated and established as Business Unit #C01695 for the 10 Acre Commercial Site Development be programmed to construct as Phase I the electric powerline extension; and

- 7. Pursuant to Indian Wells Chapter Resolution #IW-19-147, the Indian Wells Chapter approved changes to the Sihasin Expenditure Plan for the Indian Wells 10 Acre Commercial Site Development project by inserting language in the Project Type by including "Pre-Design, Design/Construction, and Equipment," in addition to Planning as well as extending the Project Duration to complete the project; and
- 8. To effect the necessary changes to the Sihasin Expenditure Plan, the assigned project staff with Capital Projects Management Department within the Navajo Division of Community Development, is to prepare and initiate the process for changes and forward the necessary documents to the respective Navajo Nation Council delegate to necessary and required action.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Indian Wells Chapter hereby supports, approves, and grants to Navajo Tribal Utility Authority (NTUA) the required and necessary utility easement for the construction of the electric powerline and waterline extensions within the previously approved and withdrawn 25.07± acres designated for business and commercial development, as shown in Exhibit A.
- 2. The Indian Wells Chapter hereby supports and approves the encumbrance and expenditure of Sihasin funds, under Business Unit #C01695, necessary to complete the construction, as Utility Development Phase I, of an electric powerline extension within the designated 25.07± business and commercial site, as outlined in the project scope of work in Exhibit B.
- 3. The Indian Wells Chapter further request the Navajo Division of Community Development, Capital Projects Management Department, to carry out the intent of Indian Wells Chapter Resolution #IW-19-147 by changing the Project Type and Project Duration within the Sihasin Expenditure Plan.

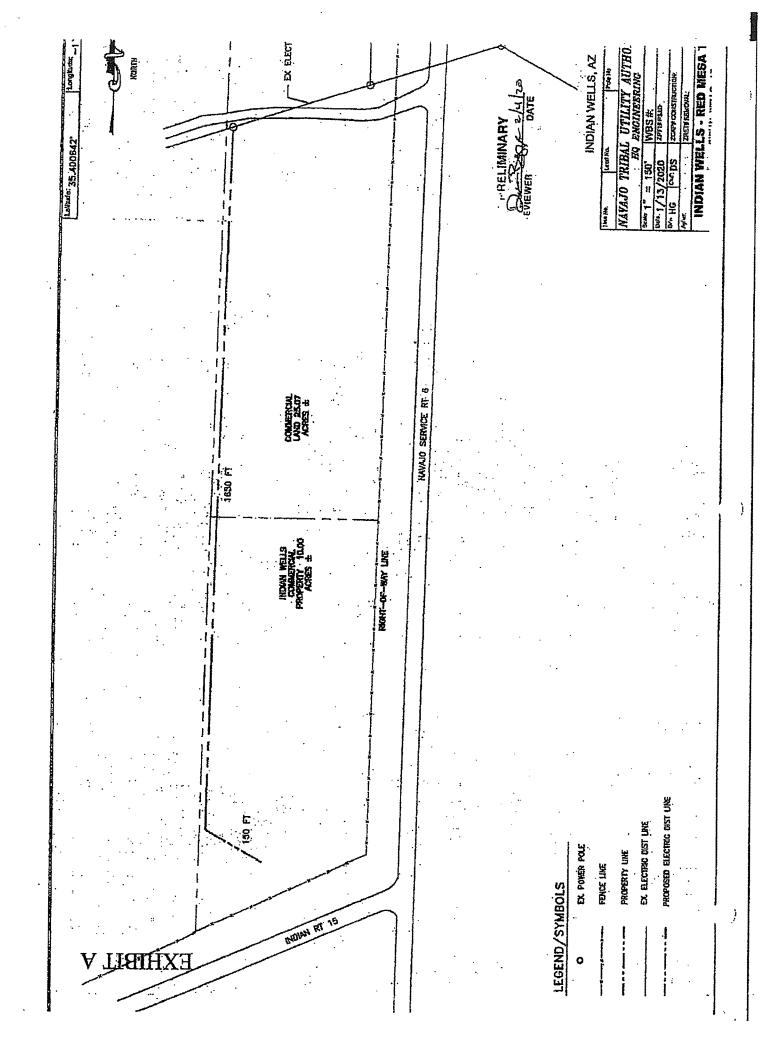
