**PURPOSE:** The resolution's purpose is to confirm Honorable Alton Joe Shepherd as a Navajo Tribal Utility Authority Management Board of Director.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

Standing Committee Authority and Power 18 The Resources and Development Committee has authority to grant final confirmation 19 of appointments to enterprise boards. 2 N.N.C. § 501(B)(9). 20 **Section Two. Findings** 21 A. Navajo Nation established an enterprise known as the Navajo Tribal Utility Authority 22 (NTUA) whose general purpose, in accordance with 21 N.N.C. § 5(A)(1-6), is to 23 operate, maintain and promote existing utility systems furnishing electric, gas, water, 24

sewer utility services, generation, and telecommunications and information services for the benefit of residents of the Navajo Nation, including the establishment, ownership, operation and maintenance of electric generating, telecommunications and information services on or off the Navajo Reservation; and to provide utility generation, telecommunications and information services on a non-profit basis and at

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- a reasonable cost to residents of the Navajo Nation consistent with the economical operation of the Enterprise. 21 N.N.C. § 2.
- B. The NTUA Management Board shall have the authority and responsibility for the management and operation of the Enterprise, among other powers and duties. *See* 21 N.N.C. § 7(A)(2-13); 21 N.N.C. § 7(B)(1-13); 21 N.N.C. § 7(C). 21 N.N.C. § 7(A)(1).
- C. The management board shall consist of seven persons, all of whom were formerly appointed by the Government Services Committee of the Navajo Nation Council, whose authority to confirm appointments to enterprise boards has since been delegated to the Resources and Development Committee pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 501(B)(9), see also CJA-03-13. 21 N.N.C. § 9(A).
- D. Directors appointed to the Management Board are eligible for reappointment. 21 N.N.C. § 9(C)(1).
- E. Four of the directors shall be members of the Navajo Nation who speak English with fluency and who have sufficient education and experience to qualify them for learning utility business practices and procedures and making sound judgments. 21 N.N.C. § 9(B)(1).
- F. Directors shall be elected for three year terms and shall hold office until the qualification and selection of their successors. 21 N.N.C. §§ 9(C) and 9(C)(2).
- G. On December 3, 2014, the Resources and Development Committee confirmed the reappointment of the Honorable Leonard Tsosie to service on the Navajo Tribal Utility Authority's Management Board of Directors for a term of three years until the annual board meeting in October 2015. RDCD-88-14, 22<sup>nd</sup> Navajo Nation Council (Dec. 3, 2014).
- H. As stated above, Directors shall hold office until the selection of their successors. 21 N.N.C. § 9(C).
- On January 26, 2016, the Honorable Leonard Tsosie resigned as a Navajo Tribal Utility Authority Management Board member. EXHIBIT A.
- J. The appointment would be for a period of three years retroactive to October 2015 and would expire with the annual board meeting in October 2018. 21 N.N.C. § 9(C)(2).

### Section Three. Appointment Approval

The Navajo Nation confirms the appointment of the Honorable Alton Joe Shepherd to serve on the Navajo Tribal Utility Authority's Management Board of Directors for a term of three years until the annual board meeting in October 2018.
