TITLE OF RESOLUTION: A PROPOSED NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL RESOLUTION: AN ACTION RELATING TO RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT, BUDGET AND FINANCE AND NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEES AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; AMENDING NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL RESOLUTION CJA-12-16 AND THE SÍHASIN FUND BULK WATER & WASTEWATER DEVELOPMENT EXPENDITURE PLAN AND THE SÍHASIN FUND SDS PRROJECT EXPENDITURE PLAN TO INCLUDE WIDE RUINS WATER LINE EXTENSION (PHASE II)

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of the resolution is to amend Navajo Nation Council Resolution CJA-12-16 And The Síhasin Fund Bulk Water & Wastewater Development Expenditure Plan and the Síhasin Fund Sds Prroject Expenditure Plan to include Wide Ruins Water Line Extension (Phase II)

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

- D. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the budgeting, appropriation, investment, and management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. §§ 301 (B) (2).
- E. The Resource Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to exercise oversight authority over resources, including, but not limited to, water, land and agriculture, as well as community and economic development, and to establish and review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the adoption of Navajo Nation policy with respect to the optimum utilization of all Navajo Nation resources. See 2 N.N.C. §§500 (C) and 501 (B)(4).
- F. The Síhasin Subcommittee of the Naabik'iyati' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council was established to recommend to the Naabik'iyati' Committee and Navajo Nation Council financial support and/or financing plans for the purposes designated in the Navajo Nation Trust Settlement Act of 2014, 12 N.N.C. §§ 2501-2508, enacted by CD-68-14. NABIAP-20-15.

## Section Two. Findings

A. On January 27, 2016, the Navajo Nation Council adopted Resolution No. CJA-12-16, attached as Exhibit A, enacting the Síhasin Fund Bulk Water & Wastewater Development Expenditure Plan and the Síhasin Fund SDS Project Expenditure Plan and Project List and on February 21, 2016, the President of the Navajo Nation signed CJA-12-16 into law.

B. In January of 2016, the President of the Navajo Nation and Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council received the "Navajo Area IHS Sanitation Deficiency System (SDS) List – FY 2016", CJA-12-16 Exhibit B, identifying sanitation deficiencies for the Navajo Nation and listing five hundred ninety-eight (598) sanitation facilities projects, in priority order, that are necessary to correct sanitation deficiencies on the Navajo Nation.

ī	C.	The Síhasin Fund SDS Project Expenditure Plan and Project List adopted by CJA-12-
2		16 Exhibit C, funded a share of sixty-two (62) projects distributed throughout each
3		region of the Navajo Nation.
4	D.	While the Wide Ruins Waterline Extension (Phase II) is one of the 598 sanitation
5		facilities projects included on the "Navajo Area IHS Sanitation Deficiency System
6		(SDS) List - FY 2016" as set forth in CJA-12-16 Exhibit B, the project was not one
7		of the sixty-two (62) projects funded by the Síhasin Fund SDS Project Expenditure
8		Plan and Project List adopted by CJA-12-16 through CJA-12-16 Exhibit C.
9	E.	As set forth in the STARS SDS Narrative, attached as Exhibit B, there are sixty-two
10		(62) homes in the Wide Ruins community without water or sewer service; the Wide
11		Ruins Water Line Extension (Phase II) would:
12		1. Provide water services to sixty-two (62) homes by installing 158,765 lineal
13		feet of waterline and a 75k gallon water storage tank; and
14		2. Provide wastewater (septic tank/drainfields) facilities to 62 homes,
15		plumbing and bathroom additions for 32 homes.
16	F.	As also set forth in the STARS SDS Narrative, the estimated cost for the Wide
17	1.1	Ruins Water Line Extension (Phase II) is four million eight hundred eighty-six
18		dollars (\$4,886,000.00), not including a 20% contingency amount of nine hundred
19	. 6	seventy-seven thousand two hundred dollars (\$977,200.00).
20	G.	The Wide Ruins Chapter has passed resolution WDR-04-005-16, attached as
21		Exhibit C, finding that it is in the best interest of its community people for the
22		Navajo Nation to complete the Wide Ruins Water Line Extension (Phase II) project
23	11	and requesting that the project be funded through the Síhasin Fund.
24	H.	Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CD-68-14 which enacted the Navajo Nation
25		Trust Settlement Act of 2014 ("2014 Act") and established the Navajo Nation
26		Síhasin Fund at 12 N.N.C. §§2501-2508, mandates that Síhasin Fund principal and
27		income may only be expended to provide financial support and/or financing for (1)
28		the planning and development of regional infrastructure supporting economic and
29		community development, including housing, within the Navajo Nation; and/or (2)
30		

education opportunities for members of the Navajo Nation. See 12 N.N.C § 2501 and § 2502 (A).

I. The 2014 Act also established that "leveraging of the [Síhasin] Fund by way of guaranteeing loans, match funding, direct funding in part and other weighted uses of the Fund shall be favored over direct funding in whole". 12 N.N.C § 2502 (B).

J. Notwithstanding the responsibilities assigned to the Síhasin Fund Subcommittee to recommend to the Naabik'iyati' Committee and Navajo Nation Council financial support and/or financing plans for the purposes designated in the 2014 Act, the Navajo Nation Council hereby determines:

- 1. The Wide Ruins Water Line Extension (Phase II) project is regional infrastructure on the Navajo Nation and therefore meets the 2014 Act's requirement for the "planning and development of regional infrastructure supporting economic and community development, including housing, within the Navajo Nation". See 12 N.N.C. §2502 (A) (1); and
- 2. The Indian Health Services' construction of the Wide Ruins Water Line Extension (Phase II) is a form of cost-sharing that meets the 2014 Act's requirement that "leveraging of the [Síhasin] Fund by way of guaranteeing loans, match funding, direct funding in part and other weighted uses of the Fund shall be favored over direct funding in whole". 12 N.N.C § 2502 (B).

K. The Navajo Nation Council hereby determines that notwithstanding the responsibilities assigned to the Síhasin Fund Subcommittee to recommend to the Naabik'iyati' Committee and Navajo Nation Council financial support and/or financing plans for the purposes designated in the 2014 Act, amending CJA-12-16 and the Síhasin Fund SDS Project Expenditure Plan and Project List to fund the Wide Ruins Water Line Extension (Phase II) project for four million eight hundred eighty-six dollars (\$4,886,000.00) plus 20% contingency of nine hundred seventy-seven thousand two hundred dollars (\$977,200.00) is within the best interest of the Navajo Nation and Navajo communities.

Section Three.

1 A. The Navajo Nation hereby amends Resolution No. CJA-12-16, Section Two, 2 Clause D, page 12, as follows: Navajo Nation hereby additionally approves and adopts total funding for the 3 Síhasin Fund SDS Expenditure Plan and Project List of \$79,029,952.00 4 (seventy-nine million twenty-nine thousand nine hundred fifty two dollars) 5 (\$84,866,152.00) eighty-four million eight hundred sixty-six thousand one 6 hundred fifty-two dollars from Síhasin Fund Principal appropriated to the WMB 7 over a five-year period, starting in Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2017, to construct 8 selected SDS projects, as set forth in Exhibit C, in each of the twenty-four (24) 9 Council Delegate districts or regions as follows: 10 11 1. Year 1: The appropriation and expenditure of \$20,000,000.00 (twenty 12 million dollars) \$25,863,200.00 (twenty-five million eight hundred sixty-13 three thousand two hundred dollars) in Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2017 for 14 the first year of SDS projects set forth in the SDS Project List. 15 2. Year 2: The appropriation and expenditure of \$15,000,000.00 (fifteen 16 million dollars) in Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2018 for the second year of 17 SDS projects set forth in SDS Project List. 18 3. Year 3: The appropriation and expenditure of \$15,000,000.00 (fifteen 19 million dollars) in Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2019 for the third year of SDS 20 projects set forth in SDS Project List. 21 4. Year 4: The appropriation and expenditure of \$15,000,000.00 (fifteen 22 million dollars) in Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2020 for the fourth year of 23 SDS projects set forth in SDS Project List. 24 5. Year 5: The appropriation and expenditure of \$14,029,952.00 (fourteen 25 million twenty-nine thousand nine hundred fifty-two dollars) in 26 Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2021 for the fifth year of SDS projects set forth 27 in SDS Project List. 28 29 B. The Navajo Nation hereby amends Resolution No. CJA-12-16 Exhibit C, titled the 30 Síhasin Fund SDS Plan & Project List, to add the Wide Ruins Water Line

7	as follows:
8	1. The Sub-Total listed on page 1 of 2 of Exhibit C shall be increased by
9	four million eight hundred eighty-six dollars (\$4,886,000.00) to a new
10	Sub-Total of seventy million seven hundred forty-four thousand two
11	hundred ninety-three dollars (\$70,744,293.00);

### RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL

## 23RD NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL -- Second Year, 2016

### AN ACTION

RELATING TO RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT, BUDGET AND FINANCE AND NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEES AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; ADOPTING THE SÍHASIN FUND BULK WATER & WASTEWATER DEVELOPMENT EXPENDITURE PLAN, AND THE SIHASIN FUND SDS PROJECT EXPENDITURE PLAN AND PROJECT LIST PURSUANT TO CD-68-14 AND 12 N.N.C §§ 2501 - 2508

BE IT ENACTED:

Section One. Findings

- A. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 102 (A).
- B. The Naabik'iyati' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to review all proposed legislation which requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(9).
- C. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the budgeting, appropriation, investment, and management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. § 300(8)(2).
- D. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to exercise oversight authority over resources, including, but not limited to, water, land and agriculture, as well as community and economic development, and to establish and review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the adoption of Navajo Nation policy with respect to the optimum utilization of all Navajo Nation resources. See 2 N.N.C. §§500 (C) and 501 (B) (4).
- E. On May 30, 2014, the 22<sup>nd</sup> Navajo Nation Council adopted Resolution No. CMY-28-14 accepting a settlement of the Navajo Nation's lawsuit, Navajo Nation v. United States, No. 06-945L (United States Court of Federal Claims) against the United States for its historical mismanagement of the tribe's trust assets and its failure to ensure that the Navajo Nation received all funds due and owed under the

United States' trust obligations and fiduciary duties. Resolution No. CMY-28-14 was signed into law by the President of the Navajo Nation on June 4, 2014.

F. The 22<sup>nd</sup> Navajo Nation Council recognized that during the many decades that the United States was in breach of its trust obligations and fiduciary duties to the Nation, the tribal government was without funds to develop the comprehensive nation-wide infrastructures necessary to support and promote community growth and sustainability through the expansion of economic development, as well as to provide the educational opportunities, critical for the prosperity of current and future generations of Diné. See Resolution No. CMY-28-14.

- G. Between October 6, 2014 and November 8, 2014 the Office of the Speaker held seven (7) Public Hearings, as directed by the Navajo Nation Council's Naabik'iyati' Committee on July 10, 2014, to receive input from Navajo Nation members on how the net proceeds from Navajo Nation v. United States' should be used. During that same time period, the Office of the President & Vice-President also held five (5) town hall meetings for a similar purpose.
- H. On December 13, 2014, the 22<sup>nd</sup> Navajo Nation Council adopted Resolution No. CD-68-14 enacting the Navajo Nation Breach of Trust Settlement Act of 2014 (hereinafter "2014 Act") and establishing the Navajo Nation Síhasin Fund at 12 N.N.C. § 2501 et seq. The President of the Navajo Nation signed Resolution No. CD-68-14 into law on December 31, 2014.
- I. The 2014 Act mandated that the net proceeds and earnings thereon received by the Navajo Nation from the settlement of Navajo Nation v. United States, No. 06-945L, be deposited into the Sihasin Fund and managed and invested to provide financial support and/or financing for (1) the planning and development of regional infrastructure supporting economic and community development, including housing, within the Navajo Nation; and/or (2) education opportunities for members of the Navajo Nation. See 12 N.N.C § 2501 and § 2502 (A).

- J. The 2014 Act also established that "leveraging of the [Síhasin] Fund by way of guaranteeing loans, match funding, direct funding in part and other weighted uses of the Fund shall be favored over direct funding in whole". 12 N.N.C § 2502 (B).
- K. The 2014 Act further established that with the exception of outstanding and accrued litigation costs, Sihasin Fund Principal and Income shall only be expended pursuant to a Fund Expenditure Plan consistent with the purposes set forth in the 2014 Act at 12 N.N.C. §2502 and adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members of the Navajo Nation Council. See 12 N.N.C. § 2505 (A).
- L. The 2014 Act states that "Fund Principal" shall consist of all deposits made to the Sihasin Fund and that "Fund Income" shall consist of all earnings (interest, dividends, etc.) generated and realized by the Fund Principal and that Fund Income shall be deposited in and added to Fund Principal until such time as a Fund Expenditure Plan is duly adopted. See 12 N.N.C. §§ 2504 and 2505 (c).
- M. The Office of the Controller reported that as of January 1, 2016, the amount of the Síhasin Fund Principal is Four Hundred Eighty Seven Million Nine Hundred Ninety Thousand Eight Hundred Forty One Dollars and Ninety One Cents (\$487,990,841.91) with interest earnings of Four Hundred Fifty Eight Thousand Four Hundred Thirty One Dollars and Seventy Five Cents (\$458,431.75).
- N. On April 9, 2015, the Naabik'íyáti' Committee adopted NABIAP-20-15 establishing the Naabik'íyáti' Síhasin Fund Subcommittee to "review and evaluate the Public Hearing comments and recommendations from the Navajo People" and "recommend to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee and Navajo Nation Council financial support and/or financing plan(s) for the purposes designated in CD-68-14 [Navajo Nation Breach of Trust Settlement Act of 2014, establishing the Síhasin Fund]".
- O. Between April 2015 and January 2016, the Naabik'iyáti' Síhasin Fund Subcommittee, assisted by the Office of Legislative Services, Office of the Speaker, and Office of Legislative Counsel, met on at least twelve (12) occasions

in either work sessions or official meetings to review and evaluate the Public Hearing comments and recommendations from the Navajo People; hear proposals from Navajo Nation entities, chapters, programs and officials; and develop an expenditure plan for the Síhasin Fund Principal and Income consistent with the purposes set forth in the 2014 Act.

- P. The Naabik'íyáti' Síhasin Fund Subcommittee determined that for an expenditure plan to fully meet the leveraging criteria of the 2014 Act, the expenditure plan shall not rely on Síhasin Funds for full direct project funding, unless such funds are to be repaid under a loan agreement, and instead must utilize the Síhasin Funds for (1) match funding, joint funding, contribution funding, cost-share funding or similar weighted uses of the funds; (2) reimbursement funding; and/or (3) loan or bond financing or guarantee.
- Q. The Naabik'íyáti' Síhasin Fund Subcommittee also determined that the 2014 Act allowed for the adoption of multiple expenditure plans and that it would be prudent for the Navajo Nation to adopt integrated, yet distinct, expenditure plans for regional-level infrastructure planning and development in four broad infrastructure areas or categories consistent with the purposes of the 2014 Act: Water and Natural Resource Infrastructure Development; Economic Development; Community Development; and Housing Development.
- R. After reviewing the proposals submitted during the Public Hearings and town hall meetings, as well as the proposals presented during Naabik'íyáti' Síhasin Fund Subcommittee meetings, the Subcommittee determined that (1) the lack of a comprehensive nationwide bulk water delivery system or infrastructure, as well as wastewater treatment facilities, will delay and impede true sustainable economic, community and housing development; and (2) the development of an integrated bulk water supply and wastewater treatment services was critical to and would support the realization of the economic development, community development and housing project proposals submitted during the Public Hearings and town hall meetings, as well as the proposals presented to the Subcommittee.

- S. The Naabik'íyáti' Síhasin Fund Subcommittee also determined that it was in the best long-term interests of the Navajo Nation overall to provide the financial support necessary to plan and develop an integrated nationwide bulk water supply and wastewater treatment infrastructure sufficient to support sustainable economic, community and housing development and growth throughout the Navajo Nation prior to funding specific economic, community and housing development projects.
- T. The Naabik'íyáti' Síhasin Fund Subcommittee further determined that it was in the best long-term interests of the Navajo people collectively for the Navajo Nation Council to adopt a Síhasin Fund expenditure plan for the planning and development of a nationwide bulk water delivery system or infrastructure, including wastewater treatment facilities, to support and sustain comprehensive nationwide economic, community and housing development prior to adopting project specific economic, community and/or housing development expenditure plans.
- the Naabik'íyáti' Síhasin Fund Subcommittee During U. meetings, the Navajo Tribal Utility Authority ("NTUA") and the Navajo Nation Water Management Branch ("WMB") jointly submitted a five-year proposal, hereinafter referred to as the "Bulk Water & Wastewater Development Expenditure Plan", attached as Exhibit A, to take maximum advantage of federal, state and private funding opportunities and partnerships to subsidize Navajo Nation bulk water delivery and wastewater development projects pursuant to costsharing, multi-agency contribution and reimbursement strategies as part of a cohesive global Navajo Nation water supply plan targeting five interrelated project categories:
  - 1. The establishment of bulk water capacity and the treatment and transmission of that bulk water to the delivery systems.
  - 2. The improvement of existing water systems through renovation, upgrade and capacity increase to accommodate the delivery of new bulk water.
  - 3. The construction of new plants, as well as the upsizing or replacement of existing plants, to process new bulk water.

- 4. The development and construction of bridge water projects, such as new ground water wells, to bridge the capacity until the larger capacity reaches certain areas that are farthest from the bulk water sources.
- 5. The interconnection of lines that will network water systems together to move water from system to system and eventually create the flow path to move bulk water to the farthest reaches and isolated communities.
- V. The Naabik'íyáti' Síhasin Fund Subcommittee determined that the Bulk Water & Wastewater Development Expenditure Plan presented by NTUA and WMB met the 2014 Act requirement for the "planning and development of regional infrastructure supporting economic and community development, including housing, within the Navajo Nation". See 12 N.N.C. §2502 (A) (1).
- The Naabik'íyáti' Síhasin Fund Subcommittee also determined W. that the Bulk Water & Wastewater Development Expenditure Plan met the leveraging preference criteria of the 2014 Act as (1) Sihasin Funds will only be used to fund a portion of each specific project with the majority of each project's costs reimbursed by federal, state or private entities through match funding, joint funding, contribution funding, cost-share funding or similar arrangements and agreements; and (2) Síhasin Funds allocated and dispersed to NTUA excluding the emergency reserve and replacement fund, operations and maintenance and administration costs would be repaid by NTUA to the Síhasin Fund through a loan agreement with terms equivalent or better than NTUA would receive through a United States Department of Agriculture Rural Utilities Services loan.
- X. The Naabik'iyati' Sihasin Fund Subcommittee further determined that NTUA and WMB possessed the experience and expertise necessary to implement the Bulk Water & Wastewater Development Expenditure Plan:
  - 1. NTUA was created by the Navajo Tribal Council in 1959 as a small tribally-owned water utility in order to bring electric power to Shiprock, New Mexico. The Tribal Council delegated NTUA the authority to acquire, construct, operate and

maintain utility systems for the benefits of residents of the Navajo Nation. In the decades since it was created by the Tribal Council, NTUA has expanded into electric, natural gas, water operations and sewer utility and telecommunications and grown into the largest multi-utility enterprise owned and operated by an American Indian tribe. NTUA continues to provide electric, water, wastewater, natural gas, solar energy, and telecommunications for substantial portions of the Navajo Nation and the Navajo populace.

- The goal of WMB is to protect and manage the 2. water resources of the Navajo Nation through development, review and enforcement of sound management, regulation, and planning water policies. WMB's authorities and responsibilities are to monitor the Navajo Nation's water resources, protect its water rights, restore its watersheds and manage its water resources. WMB develops water management policies, analyzes and describes the Nation's water use and demand, identifies water infrastructure deficiencies, and develops long-term water resource plans for municipal and non-municipal (irrigation, livestock, and industrial) uses.
- Y. The Naabik'íyáti' Síhasin Fund Subcommittee, after reviewing and evaluating the Public Hearing and town hall meeting comments and recommendations from the Navajo People and hearing proposals from Navajo Nation entities, chapters, programs and officials, hereby recommends the Bulk Water & Wastewater Development Expenditure Plan, attached as Exhibit A, to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee and the Navajo Nation Council as the first Fund Expenditure Plan to be funded through the Síhasin Fund under Section 2505 of the 2014 Act.
- Z. The Naabik'íyáti' Síhasin Fund Subcommittee also recommends that project specific economic, community and housing development expenditure plans, as well as education expenditure plans, be considered for funding by the Subcommittee after the Bulk Water & Wastewater Development Expenditure Plan is adopted by the Naabik'íyáti' Committee and the Navajo Nation Council.

- AA. "During its meetings, the Naabik'iyáti' Síhasin Fund Subcommittee was also presented with information about Public Law 86-121's Indian Health Service' Sanitation Deficiency System ("SDS") - a prioritized database of proposed projects to address the unmet needs of known water, wastewater, or solid waste deficiencies affecting existing Indian homes - and that the total unmet need on the Navajo Nation for SDS projects exceeded \$630,000,000.00 (six hundred thirty million dollars)."
- BB. "On January 15, 2016, the President of the Navajo Nation and Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council received the "Navajo Area IHS Sanitation Deficiency System (SDS) List - FY 2016", attached as Exhibit B, identifying sanitation deficiencies for the Navajo Nation and listing 598 sanitation facilities projects, in priority order, that are necessary to correct sanitation deficiencies on the Navajo Nation."
- CC. "Although the Navajo Area IHS secures approximately 20% of all the Public Law 86-121 funding appropriated by Congress for SDS projects, at the current level of Congressional funding it will take approximately 30 years to fund the feasible projects. See Exhibit B."
- DD. "The Navajo Nation Council determined that the Navajo Nation's development and construction of a nationwide bulk water delivery system was the creation of the foundation necessary to connect Navajo homes to a sustainable water supply, but that while the United States, pursuant to Public Laws 94-437 and 86-121, does and will provide a substantial portion of the funds to connect individual homes to that water supply, Navajo Nation Council determined it was in the best long-term interests of the Navajo people collectively for the Navajo Nation to incentivize Congress to substantially increase Navajo Nation SDS funding by appropriating a portion of Sihasin Fund Principal dedicated to funding a share of SDS projects on the Navajo Nation."
- EE. "The Navajo Nation Council further determined that funding a share of SDS Projects in each region of the Navajo Nation met the 2014 Act's requirement for the "planning and development of regional infrastructure supporting economic and community development, including

housing, within the Navajo Nation." See 12 N.N.C. § 2502(A)(1)."

FF. "After hearing the report from the Naabik'íyáti' Síhasin Fund Subcommittee on their recommendations and review of the Public Hearing and town hall meeting comments and recommendations from the Navajo People and hearing proposals from Navajo Nation entities, chapters, programs and officials, the Navajo Nation Council determined that it is in the best interests of the Navajo people to fund a share of SDS projects on the Navajo Nation using Síhasin Fund Principal appropriated to the WMB over a five-year period to construct selected SDS projects, as set forth in the Síhasin Fund SDS Expenditure Plan and Project List, attached herein as Exhibit C, in each of the twenty-four (24) Council Delegate districts or regions."

### Section Two. Approval and Adoption of Expenditure Plan

- A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves and adopts the Síhasin Fund Bulk Water & Wastewater Development Expenditure Plan, attached and incorporated herein as Exhibit A (Water and Wastewater Development Projects).
- B. The Navajo Nation hereby approves and adopts total funding for the Bulk Water & Wastewater Development Expenditure Plan of \$101,145,972.00 (one hundred one million one hundred forty-five thousand nine hundred seventy-two dollars) as follows:
  - Year 1: The appropriation and expenditure of 1. \$18,070,000.00 (eighteen million seventy thousand dollars) of Síhasin Fund Principal in Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2016 with \$13,570,000.00 (thirteen million five hundred seventy thousand of that funding allocated and dollars) appropriated to NTUA for the first year of NTUA and Wastewater Development Projects, Water operations and maintenance and including administration costs, set forth in Exhibit A, and \$4,500,000.00 (four million five hundred thousand funding allocated and that dollars) of appropriated to WMB for the first year of WMB Water and Wastewater Development Projects, including administration costs, set forth in Exhibit A; and

- 2. Year 2: The appropriation and expenditure of \$26,750,000.00 (twenty-six million seven hundred fifty thousand dollars) of Síhasin Fund Principal in Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2017 with \$18,150,000.00 (eighteen million one hundred fifty thousand dollars) of that funding allocated and appropriated to NTUA for the second year of NTUA Water and Wastewater Development Projects, including operations and maintenance and administration costs, set forth in Exhibit A, and \$8,600,000.00 (eight million six hundred thousand that funding allocated dollars) of and appropriated to WMB for the second year of WMB Water and Wastewater Development Projects, including administration costs, set forth in Exhibit A; and
- Year 3: The appropriation and expenditure of 3. \$22,525,972.00 (twenty-two million five hundred twenty-five thousand nine hundred seventy-two dollars) of Síhasin Fund Principal in Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2018 with \$20,525,972.00 (twenty million five hundred twenty-five thousand nine hundred seventy-two dollars) of that funding allocated and appropriated to NTUA for the third year of NTUA Water and Wastewater Development Projects, including operations and maintenance and administration costs, set forth in Exhibit A, and \$2,000,000.00 (two million dollars) of that funding allocated and appropriated to the WMB for the third year of WMB Water and Wastewater Development Projects, including administration costs, set forth in Exhibit A; and
- Year 4: The appropriation and expenditure of 4. \$19,150,000.00 (nineteen million one hundred fifty thousand dollars) of Síhasin Fund Principal Nation Fiscal Year 2019 with in Navajo \$18,850,000.00 (eighteen million eight hundred fifty thousand dollars) of that funding allocated and appropriated to NTUA for the fourth year of NTUA Water and Wastewater Development Projects, including operations and maintenance and administration costs, set forth in Exhibit A, and \$300,000.00 (three hundred thousand dollars) of that funding allocated and appropriated to the

WMB for the fourth year of WMB Water and Development Projects, Wastewater including administration costs, set forth in Exhibit A; and

Year 5: The appropriation and expenditure of 5. \$14,650,000.00 (fourteen million six hundred fifty thousand dollars) of Síhasin Fund Principal in Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2020 with \$14,350,000.00 (fourteen million three hundred fifty thousand dollars) of that funding allocated and appropriated to NTUA for the fifth year of NTUA Water and Wastewater Development Projects, including operations and maintenance and administration costs, set forth in Exhibit A, and \$300,000.00 (three hundred thousand dollars) of that funding allocated and appropriated to the WMB for the fifth year of WMB Water and Wastewater Development Projects , including administration costs, set forth in Exhibit A.

- 6. The annual allocations and appropriations to NTUA shall be repaid through a loan agreement(s) between the NTUA and the Navajo Nation approved by the Budget & Finance Committee with loan terms at least equivalent to and no less favorable than the terms NTUA would receive if borrowing the dollars through the United States Department of Agriculture Rural Services Utilities' loan program.
- 7. The appropriations for years 2017 through 2020 (years two through five) to both NTUA and WMB, individually or collectively, may be further leveraged by bond or loan financing pursuant to the Navajo Nation Bond Financing Act, 12 N.N.C. § 1300 et seq., as amended, using Síhasin Fund Earnings for repayment and financing costs upon recommendation of the Budget & Finance the Committee and approval by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members of the Navajo Nation Council.
- "The Navajo Nation hereby additionally approves and adopts C. the Sihasin Fund SDS Expenditure Plan and Project List, attached and incorporated herein as Exhibit C (SDS Project List)."

- D. "The Navajo Nation hereby additionally approves and adopts total funding for the Síhasin Fund SDS Expenditure Plan and Project List of \$79,029,952.00 (seventy-nine million twenty-nine thousand nine hundred fifty-two dollars) from Síhasin Fund Principal appropriated to the WMB over a fiveyear period, starting in Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2017, to construct selected SDS projects, as set forth in Exhibit C, in each of the twenty-four (24) Council Delegate districts or regions as follows:
  - Year 1: The appropriation and expenditure of \$20,000,000.00 (twenty million dollars) in Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2017 for the first year of SDS projects set forth in the SDS Project List.
  - 2. Year 2: The appropriation and expenditure of \$15,000,000.00 (fifteen million dollars) in Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2018 for the second year of SDS projects set forth in SDS Project List.
  - 3. Year 3: The appropriation and expenditure of \$15,000,000.00 (fifteen million dollars) in Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2019 for the third year of SDS projects set forth in SDS Project List.
  - 4. Year 4: The appropriation and expenditure of \$15,000,000.00 (fifteen million dollars) in Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2020 for the fourth year of SDS projects set forth in SDS Project List.
  - 5. Year 5: The appropriation and expenditure of \$14,029,952.00 (fourteen million twenty-nine thousand nine hundred fifty-two dollars) in Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2021 for the fifth year of SDS projects set forth in SDS Project List.
- E. "The appropriations for years 2017 through 2021 (years one through five) to WMB, collectively or individually, may be further leveraged by bond or loan financing pursuant to the

Section Three. Approval and Adoption of Expenditure Plan Administration.

The annual appropriation to WMB for Water and Wastewater Development Projects set forth in Exhibit A shall be released to WMB by the end of the second quarter of the respective Navajo Nation Fiscal Year and placed in and added to a continuing account which shall not lapse on an annual basis pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §820 (N) or otherwise be returned to or deposited in the Síhasin Fund principal or Navajo Nation General Fund until such time as all WMB projects listed on Exhibit A, as revised, are fully completed.
- The appropriation(s) to fund the NTUA Water and Wastewater D. Development Projects, excluding the emergency reserve and maintenance fund, operations and and replacement administration costs, shall be supported by and administered through a Loan Agreement approved by the Budget & Finance Committee which shall at least include administrative provisions that:
  - NTUA shall have the authority and responsibility to administer and use the appropriated Sihasin Funds solely to design, plan and construct the NTUA Water and Wastewater Development Projects

set forth on Exhibit A, including the authority and responsibility to enter into match funding, partnership, cooperative and other cost saving or cost sharing arrangements and leveraging agreements with other Navajo Nation enterprises and entities, Navajo Nation chapters and other political subdivisions, Navajo Nation programs, including WBA, and federal and state agencies and such agreements are not and shall not be treated as or deemed to be procurement contracts subject to the Navajo Nation Procurement Act, 12 N.N.C. §§ 301-371 or Navajo Business Opportunity Act 5 N.N.C. §§ 201-215.

- 3. NTUA shall report the status of the NTUA Water and Wastewater Development Projects to the Resources & Development Committee on a quarterly basis.
- E. The appropriation(s) to fund the WMB Water and Wastewater Development Projects, including administration costs, shall be governed by and administered through a Fund Management Plan(s) approved by the Budget & Finance Committee, which shall include that the accounting and financial records for the continuing account shall be kept separate from the Navajo Nation General Fund.
- F. WMB shall have the authority and responsibility to administer, oversee and use the appropriated funds to design, plan and construct the WMB Water and Wastewater Development Projects set forth on Exhibit A, including, but not limited to, the specific authority and responsibility to:
  - Account for the money spent out of the appropriation(s). Such accounting or expenditure report shall be included as part of the Branch's quarterly program report submitted to the Resources & Development Committee.

Any costs saved, reduced or reimbursed through leveraging shall remain in the respective continuing account and be expended to design, plan or construct the Water and Wastewater Development Projects listed in Exhibit A or with the approval of the Naabik'íyáti' Committee, projects subsequently eligible for inclusion on the Water and Wastewater Development Projects list.
- H. "The Navajo Nation Council hereby approves administration of the Síhasin Funds for the SDS Expenditure Plan and Project List as follows:
  - 1. The annual appropriation(s) shall be released to WMB by the end of the second quarter of the respective Navajo Nation Fiscal Year and placed in and added to a continuing account which shall not lapse on an annual basis pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §820 (N) or otherwise be returned to or deposited in the Síhasin Fund or Navajo Nation General Fund until such time as all SDS projects set forth in Exhibit C are fully completed.
  - 2. The annual appropriations to WMB for the SDS Project List, including the contingency amount, shall be governed by and administered through a Fund Management Plan(s) approved by the Budget &

Finance Committee, which shall include that the accounting and financial records for the continuing account shall be kept separate from the Navajo Nation General Fund.

3. WMB shall have the authority and responsibility to administer, oversee and use the appropriated funds to design, plan and construct the SDS Project List set forth in Exhibit C, including, but not limited to, the specific authority and responsibility to:

- a. Account for the money spent out of the appropriation(s). Such accounting or expenditure report shall be included as part of the Branch's quarterly program report submitted to the Resources & Development Committee.
- b. Enter into match funding, partnership, cooperative and other cost saving or cost sharing arrangements or leveraging agreements with Navajo Nation enterprises and entities, Navajo Nation chapters and other political subdivisions, other Navajo Nation programs and federal and state agencies, specifically including the Indian Health Service, and such agreements shall not be deemed procurement contracts subject to the Navajo Nation Procurement Act, 12 N.N.C. §§ 301-371 or Navajo Business Opportunity Act 5 N.N.C. §§ 201-215.
- c. After consultation with the Indian Health Service and NTUA, prioritize the projects on the SDS Project List to ensure efficient and expeditious completion of all projects and to submit a priority report to the Resources & Development Committee on a semi-annual basis.

- 4. WMB shall also have the continuing authority and responsibility to work with Indian Health Services to identify ways to further leverage the appropriated Sihasin Funds and shall present an annual leveraging plan to the Resource & Development and Budget & Finance Committees during the first quarter of each Navajo Nation Fiscal Year. Any costs saved, reduced or reimbursed through leveraging shall remain in the respective continuing account and be expended to design, plan or construct the SDS projects listed in Exhibit C or with the approval of the Naabik'íyáti' Committee, projects subsequently eligible for inclusion on the SDS Projects List.
- 5. On a quarterly basis, the Navajo Nation Washington Office shall report to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee on the status of efforts to secure Congressional appropriations above historical levels for SDS projects on the Navajo Nation."

## Section Four. Effective Date

The Síhasin Fund Bulk Water & Wastewater Development Expenditure Plan, and the Síhasin Fund SDS Expenditure Plan and Project List as set forth above, shall become effective pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 2505.

### Section Five. Directives

A. All Navajo Nation programs, specifically including, but not limited to, the Office of Controller and Office of Management & Budget, shall take all steps necessary to expeditiously implement the Bulk Water & Wastewater Development Expenditure Plan and the Síhasin Fund SDS Expenditure Plan and Project List, consistent with the provisions set forth above. B. The Navajo Tribal Utility Authority and the Navajo Nation Water Management Branch shall be held accountable for the progress of projects under their responsibility and control after the funds for such projects have been distributed by the Office of Controller and shall report on a semi-annual basis to the Navajo Nation Council on the progress for their respective projects and the expenditure of funds appropriated.

Dear Honorable President Begaye:

Attached please find the most recent Indian Health Service (IHS) Sanitation Deficiency System (SDS) report for domestic water, waste water and solid waste unmet needs for existing Navajo homes. The SDS is mandated by Public Law 94-437, the Indian Health Care Improvement Act, as amended. Although we update this list annually and submit it to our Headquarters office for inclusion into the national list, it may be amended at any time, and we seek and welcome your comments for the purpose of thoroughness. This Navajo SDS list was reviewed and updated during the 2015 calendar year, and was officially made part of the IHS Headquarters record on January 6 of this year.

The first page of the report is a summary page of all the identified sanitation deficiencies for the Navajo Nation. The following pages of the report is a one-line listing of the 598 sanitation facilities projects, in priority order, that are necessary to correct these sanitation deficiencies. The funding priority is based on several factors, with the dominant factor being the cost per home of each project.

The total estimated cost of these projects is approximately \$633 million, a decrease of approximately \$74 million from the previous year. The total cost of projects that are considered economically feasible also decreased by approximately \$50 million, to \$295 million. Although the Navajo Area IHS, one of twelve IHS Areas nationally, secures approximately 20% of all the Public Law 86-121 funding by Congress for these projects, at the current level of funding it will take approximately 30 years to fund the feasible projects.

In preparing this SDS list we have worked with the local Chapters, the Navajo Tribal Utility Authority, and the Nation's Department of Water Resources. 


