Dear Honorable Delegates of the 25th Navajo Nation Council,

I am in support of signing into law Resolution CMA-14-24, which approves \$965,485 from the Undesignated Fund Balance (UUFB) to the Navajo Election Administration to ensure that the primary and special elections will occur during Fiscal Year 2024. One of the special elections includes an election to fill the Council Delegate seated vacated by former Speaker Seth Damon.

This funding will also go to many different uses. One use is to repair certain Election Administration agency offices and hire an employee to upkeep the repairs. Another use is to hire temporary employees who make sure the primary and special elections run smoothly. A third use is to advertise the elections on the radio.

The vote is critical to a thriving democracy. I support the right to vote and as such, I am happy to sign this legislation into law. However, it is important that the Election Administration budget appropriately. I caution that the Election Adminsitration to expend the funds thoughtfully and judiciously, especially for items that are foreseeable.

RESOLUTION OF THE
NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL
25th NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL - SECOND YEAR, 2024

AN ACTION

RELATING TO AN EMERGENCY FOR THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING \$965,485 FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE ("UUFB") FOR THE NAVAJO ELECTION ADMINISTRATION FOR ITS EXPENSES IN PREPARATION FOR THE 2024 NAVAJO NATION ELECTIONS

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 102(A). As such, the Council may consider proposed legislation regarding an emergency matter. 2 N.N.C. § 164(A) (16).
- B. "[M]atters constituting an emergency shall be limited to the cessation of law enforcement services, and disaster relief services, fire protection services or other direct services required as an entitlement under Navajo Nation or Federal law, or which directly threaten the sovereignty of the Navajo Nation. Such an emergency matter must arise due to the pressing public need for such resolution(s) and must be a matter requiring final action by the Council." 2 N.N.C. § 164(A) (16).
- C. At this time, the Navajo Nation Council is concerned that the Navajo Election Administration ("NEA") currently does not have enough funds in its budget to adequately prepare for and properly conduct, all of the upcoming 2024 elections that will be held across the Navajo Nation, or to fulfill its post-election duties to properly tally all legitimate votes cast and to publish all election results.
- D. The Navajo Nation Council therefore finds that the NEA's request for \$965,485 in supplemental funding, as explained below, is indeed an emergency matter because the NEA's lack of funds "directly threaten[s] the sovereignty of the Navajo Nation" and there certainly exists a "pressing public need" for the requested funds.
- E. The Navajo Nation Council is empowered to approve supplemental appropriations during the current fiscal year if, and when, additional incoming revenue to the Navajo Nation is expected to surpass initial or current revenue projections, and such

revenue exceeds the 10% minimum reserve mandated by § 820(J). 12 N.N.C. § 820(L).

F. The restrictions on supplemental appropriations, including all amounts from the UUFB, include:

1. Payment of recurring government operating expenses shall be from recurring revenues, and payment of nonrecurring expenses shall be from nonrecurring revenues such as UUFB funds. 12 N.N.C. § 820(E), § 820(F).
2. Specifically, the UUFB shall not be used for recurring government expenditures or operations. 12 N.N.C. § 820(J), § 820(L).
3. Nonrecurring revenues, such as UUFB funds, may be used only after the Controller determines whether or not such revenues are subsidizing an imbalance between the Navajo Nation's recurring revenues and expenditures, and government expenditures shall only be authorized if a long-term (3-year to 5-year) forecast shows that the operating deficit will not continue; otherwise, nonrecurring revenues will be added to the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance. 12 N.N.C. § 820(F).
4. The above provisions in Title 12 may be amended or waived by a two-thirds vote of the full Navajo Nation Council. 12 N.N.C. § 820(F), 12 N.N.C. § 880.
5. In compliance with 12 N.N.C. § 820(F) all UUFB funding requests must be reviewed by the Controller. Such review is also required because the Controller determines which revenues and expenses are recurring and which are non-recurring. 12 N.N.C. § 820(L).
6. In compliance with 12 N.N.C. § 820(M) all UUFB funding requests must also be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget ("OMB") for a budget impact analysis.
7. In accordance with 12 N.N.C. § 820(N), the approved UUFB funds shall lapse at the end of the current fiscal year unless the Navajo Nation Council decides otherwise by a 7/8 vote.

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

A. The Navajo Election Administration ("NEA") is requesting \$965,485 from the UUFB to hire temporary employees, to renovate

its facilities, and to cover its operating expenses for the remainder of FY2024. NEA believes this funding request should be viewed as an emergency matter, because such expenses are necessary for NEA to adequately prepare for the upcoming 2024 Navajo Nation elections to be conducted across the Navajo Nation.

- B. Regarding its funding request, NEA has provided the required Navajo Nation Budget Forms and the required Appendix J "Supplemental Funding Proposal Summary." **EXHIBIT A.**
- C. The Office of the Controller has provided a memorandum regarding the requested UUFB funding, as required by 12 N.N.C. § 820(L). This memorandum indicates that the proposed expenditures are *non-recurring*. **EXHIBIT B.**
- D. The Office of Management and Budget has also provided its memorandum regarding the NEA's proposed expenditures. 12 N.N.C. § 820(M). **EXHIBIT C.**
- E. The Navajo Nation has determined that this legislation constitutes an emergency, because the requested funds are needed to ensure a *bona fide* election process for 2024, for all elections conducted across the Navajo Nation, as well as proper post-election procedures for the counting of all votes and the publication of final election results. Voting must be easily accessible to all eligible Navajo voters, and this UUFB funding will greatly assist the NEA in providing such access.

SECTION THREE. APPROVAL OF \$965,485 FROM THE UUFB FOR THE NEA'S EXPENSES IN PREPARATION FOR THE UPCOMING 2024 NAVAJO NATION ELECTIONS

- A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves a supplemental appropriation of \$965,485 out of the UUFB for the Navajo Election Administration to cover its expenses in preparation for the upcoming 2024 Navajo Nation elections, in accordance with the attached **EXHIBIT A.**
- B. The \$965,485 in UUFB funds approved herein shall be from those revenues that exceed the 10% minimum balance of the UUFB, which amount must be maintained according to 12 N.N.C. § 820(J).
- C. In accordance with 2 N.N.C. § 820(N), the \$965,485 approved herein shall lapse at the end of Fiscal Year 2024, unless otherwise decided by the Navajo Nation Council with a 7/8 vote.

SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Action shall become effective pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 221(B) and 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(17).

SECTION FIVE. SAVING CLAUSE

If any portion of this Action is determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or by a District Court of the Navajo Nation without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the remainder of this Action shall be the law of the Navajo Nation.

CERTIFICATION

I, hereby, certify that the foregoing resolution was duly considered by the 25th Navajo Nation Council at a duly called meeting in Window Rock, Navajo Nation (Arizona), at which a quorum was present and that the same was passed by a vote of 12 in Favor, and 02 Opposed, on this 26th day of March 2024.

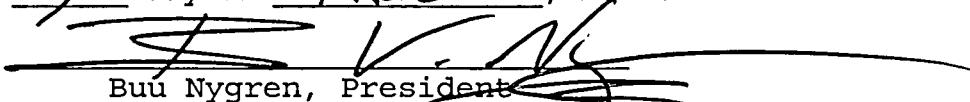

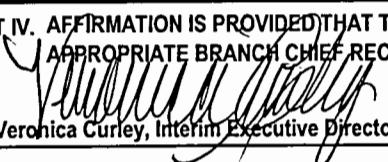
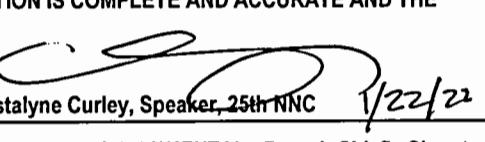

PART II. REASON FOR REQUEST AND STATEMENT OF NEED:			
<p>The Navajo Election Administration is requesting supplemental funding to cover short fall for the FY'2024. Personnel Expense (.2000) at \$65,464 to hire temporary employees to assist with the FY'2024 Primary & Special Elections. In addition, we are also in the process of hiring a FT- Regular Maintenance Technician to assist and maintain the NEA dilapidated buildings and offices at each five agencies. We recently purchased building materials for Chinle Office due to lack of funding to purchase a new office building. The renovation and repairs are needed before cold winter and before the election 2024. Travel Expense (.3000) is requested in the amount of \$7,505 for staff to travel to provide voters registration, absentee voting, voter registration trainings and attend work sessions. The Meeting Expense (.3500) requesting for the amount of \$346,681 for 440 Poll Workers and 110 Chief Poll Judges to be compensated for the two Special Elections at Tuba City and the Special Elections for the additional six (6) chapters in Eastern Agency that Council Delegate Seth Damon represented. In addition, Primary Election will be held in August 2024, there maybe a Referendum included and NEA will need additional Poll Workers of 220. The Supplies (.4000) requesting in the amount of \$401,656; for election supplies, printing, postage, and general supplies for each agency and the NEA office. The Lease & Rentals (.5000) is requested for the amount of \$61,890 for the Office Space Rental with Quality Inn Office Complex; Storage Units (2) at Fort Defiance Storage; and Pitney Bowes equipment for our postage meter. Communications and Utilities (.5500) requesting for \$7,289 to keep our business cell phones in operation for our election purposes; in addition we also need the WIFI (hot-spot) equipment that is used during our travel to conduct VR Drives, training and work sessions. Repairs and Maintenace (.6000) requesting for \$4,000 renovation supplies & materials and the services for equipments. Special Transactions (.7000) requesting of \$35,000 to purchase promotional items, radio advertisement, live shows from KGAK, KTNN and KNDN for Election Purposes. Capital Outlay (.9000) \$36,000 is needed to purchase storage units for NEA and Chinle Office to store election equipment after each election with all five agencies.</p>

1. OMB has reviewed the submitted Budget Forms and finds them to be in good order.
2. In FY 2024, a \$300,000 budget was approved for the Navajo Elections in the Fixed Cost group. The majority of this allocation is for consultants. This amount is in addition to the regular Navajo Election budget of \$1,082,931.
3. If approved, the requested \$965,485 from the UUFB will add to the overall amount totaling \$2,348,416 for the Election Administration.
