## RESOLUTION OF THE RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE 23rd Navajo Nation Council --- Fourth Year, 2018

#### AN ACTION

RELATING TO RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE; APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL ONE AND ONE QUARTER ACRE (1.24) MORE OR LESS, TO THE REVOCABLE USE PERMIT FOR MISSION SITE ISSUED TO THE POTTER'S HOUSE CHRISTIAN CHURCH OF CHINLE, INC., IN CHINLE CHAPTER, NAVAJO NATION

#### Section One. Authority

- A. Pursuant to 16 N.N.C. § 1151 (C), the Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council has the authority to give approval for permits of mission sites on behalf of the Navajo Nation.
- B. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 501 (B)(2), the Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council has the authority to give final approval for all land withdrawals, non-mineral leases, permits, licenses, rights-of-way, surface easements and bonding requirements on Navajo Nation lands and unrestricted (fee) land. This authority shall include subleases, modifications, assignments, leasehold encumbrances, transfers, renewals, and terminations.

### Section Two. Title 16 of the Navajo Nation Code Provisions with Respect to Mission Sites

- A. Pursuant to 16 N.N.C. § 1153 (A), no permit to enlarge the area of Navajo Nation land presently under permit to a missionary or mission body, and no permit to grant Navajo Nation land for a new mission site will be granted by the Resources and Development Committee, unless the application for such permit has first been reviewed by the Navajo Land Department of the Navajo Nation.
- B. Pursuant to 16 N.N.C. § 1153 (B), the application for a mission site shall contain:
  - 1. An exact description of the Navajo Nation land for which application is made.

- 2. A detailed statement of the purpose or purposes for which the said Navajo Nation land shall be used. If a missionary or mission body proposes to establish facilities for educational, medical, or other non-religious activities, the application shall set forth fully the extent and character thereof.
- 3. A signed petition of a substantial number of Navajos residing in the vicinity of the proposed site endorsing the proposed permit.
- 4. An endorsement of Navajo Nation Council Delegates of the District in which the proposed site is located.
- 5. A description of buildings and improvements to be placed on Navajo Nation lands and an estimate of the cost thereof. Pursuant to 16 N.N.C. § 1155, the Resources and Development Committee is authorized to deny or grant, on behalf of the Navajo Nation, any permit with special consideration to the establishment of too many missions in any one area or at any one point.
- C. Pursuant to 16 N.N.C. § 1159 (B), the following acreage limitations shall apply to all applicants for permits:
  - 1. Mission site for purely religious activities: one and one-half (1 1/2) acres;
  - 2. Mission site for religious activities and community services facilities: three and one-half (3 1/2) acres;
  - 3. Mission site for religious activities and either substantial medical or accredited educational programs: eight (8) acres; and
  - 4. The Resources and Development Committee may, in the case of applications for mission sites in or near areas withdrawn for townships in the Navajo Nation, limit site acreage to less than two and five-tenths (2 5/10) acres, and may set rental fees with due regard for present or future competing demands for land use in such areas.

- D. Pursuant to 16 N.N.C. § 1159 (C), "community service facilities" shall be deemed to include only those permanent improvements upon the permitted site which are for the purpose of providing recreational programs, non-religious educational programs, including adult education, and other non-religious programs of benefit to the community.
- E. Pursuant to 16 N.N.C. § 1160 (A), the acreage limitations established by 16 N.N.C. § 1159 may be waived by the Resources and Development Committee upon a showing by the applicant that planned programs will be of sufficient benefit to the Navajo People to justify waiver of acreage limitations. No waiver of acreage limitations shall be granted unless the applicant has complied with 16 N.N.C. §§ 1153 and 1161, and all other procedures provided by law.
- F. Pursuant to 16 N.N.C.  $\S$  1160 (B), no waiver of acreage limitations shall be granted in cases of applications subject to acreage limitations established by 16 N.N.C.  $\S$  1159(B) (1).
- G. Pursuant to 16 N.N.C. § 1161, no application for a mission site permit for an area of Navajo Nation land in excess of the limitations established in 16 N.N.C. § 1159 shall be granted by the Resources and Development Committee, unless the application for such permit has been reviewed and approved by the Division of Community Development of the Navajo Nation, and by the Navajo Land Department of the Navajo Nation.

#### Section Three. Findings

- A. The Potter's House Christian Church of Chinle, Inc., has applied for an additional 1.24 acres, more or less, to be added to the Revocable Use Permit for Mission Site issued pursuant to Resolution RDCJA-03-16 within the Chinle Chapter. See Exhibit A.
- B. Consent to use Navajo Nation land for religious activities has been given by the grazing permit holder as attested to by the Project Review Section of the Navajo Land Department. See Exhibit B.
- C. The land description appears on the survey plat. See **Exhibit**B.
- D. The Chinle Chapter, by Resolution CHIN-JUL-17-043, has approved the addition of 1.24 acres, more or less, to the

existing Revocable Use Permit for Mission Site. See **Exhibit** C.

- E. The request for a mission site permit has been reviewed and found sufficient by the Navajo Nation Fish and Wildlife, Historic Preservation, General Land Department and the Department of Justice. See **Exhibit B**.
- F. The Potter's House Christian Church of Chinle, Inc., will use the requested 1.24 acres, more or less, for "Expansion of parking lot, all-purpose building addition, outside activities basketball and volleyball courts, Children Church, Sunday School, Child Care, room for tents and larger events." See Exhibit A. Application for Revocable Use Permit (Religious Site) Navajo Nation Lands.
- G. The requested 1.24 acres, more or less, will bring the total acreage for the Potter's House Christian Church of Chinle, Inc., to 2.74 acres, more or less, when combined with the previously Resources and Development Committee Resolution RDCJA-03-16, approved 1.5 acres, more or less. See Exhibit A.
- H. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council finds that the requested 1.24 acres, more or less, will be used for community service facilities pursuant to 16 N.N.C.

#### Section Four. Approval

- A. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby approves the addition of 1.24 acres, more or less, to the existing Revocable Use Permit for Mission Site as issued to the Potter's House Church of Chinle, Inc., as described in **Exhibit C**.
- B. All existing Terms and Conditions remain unchanged and in effect.
- C. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby authorizes the President of the Navajo Nation to execute all documents to affect the intent and purpose of this resolution.

#### Section One. Findings

- A. Pursuant to 16 N.N.C., Section 1151(C), the Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council has authority to give approval for permits for mission sites on behalf of the Navajo Nation; and
- B. The Potter's House of Chinle, Inc., Post Office Box 2585, Chinle, Arizona 86503 has applied for Revocable Use Permit for Mission Site within the Chinle Chapter, as further described in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference; and
- C. The mission site is located on 1.5. acres of trust lands in the Southwest Quarter (SW1/4) of Section 20, Township 32 North, Range 26 East, in the vicinity of Chinle Chapter, Navajo Nation (Apache County, Arizona). The land description appears on the survey plat attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "B"; and
- D. The District Grazing Official identified one land user, Foster Gorman and his consent is attached hereto as "Exhibit "C." The chapter resolution and the signed petition by the local residents are also attached as Exhibit "D"; and
- E. Biological, Historical, Cultural and Archeological surveys and clearances for this permit were completed including an Environmental Assessment report, and are all attached and labeled as Exhibit "E"; and
- F. On June 16, 2015, the Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council through RDCJN-35-15 delegated the director of Navajo Land Department, Division of Natural Resources, the power and authority to give final approval of all land withdrawal designations on the Navajo Nation. The Land Withdrawal Designation has been approved for the mission site for the Potter's House of Chinle, Inc., for 1.5 acres of tribal trust land for five (5) years, attached hereto



The proposed location of the church site tract addition is more particularly described Southwest Quarter (SW¼) of Section 20, Township 32 North, Range 26 East, Chinle, Apache County, Arizona. See attached survey plat.

During the initial assignment, I had to check with the Navajo Nation Economic Development Office at Chinle Regional Business Development on the proposed addition to the present church site because of a business site corridor in the area. Upon further site analysis of the area it was found that the previous land survey was encroaching into the approved NTUA tract description. Therefore, a resurvey was requested on the proposed site which is reflected on the revised land survey that contains 1.24 acres, more or less.

The affected grazing permittee has consented to proceed with the proposed site addition for the Potter's House Christian Church of Chinle, Inc.

AMENDING CHIN-AUG-16-054 SUPPORTING CHINLE POTTER'S HOUSE CHRISTIAN CENTER TO OBTAIN AN ADDITIONAL 1.24 ACRES 1.40 ACRES TO TOTAL 2.74 MORE OR LESS ACRES.

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. Chinle Chapter, a recognized certified local government of the Navajo Nation, vested with the power and authority to advocate on behalf of its constituents for the improvement of health, education, safety, and general welfare; and
- 2. The existing Potter's House Christian Center was approved by the Resources and Development Committee for 1.5 acres on January 05, 2016. The church is seeking an additional 1.24 acres for a total of 2.74 acres more or less; and
- 3. During field clearance of the site, Mr. Raymond Pine, Appraiser with Navajo Land Department (attached Memo dated 02/07/2017) finds that the previous land survey was encroaching into the approved NTUA tract, a resurvey was requested; and
- 4. Alpha Omega Engineering & Survey resurveyed the site reflecting the correct acreage of 1.24 acres; and
- 5. Pursuant to Title 16, Chapter 11 §1159, Acreage Limitations Generally: B(2) Mission site for religious activities and community service facilities: three and one half acres; and
- 6. Chinle Potters House Christian Church wishes to expand their area to include:
  - Buildings to accommodate classes, programs and recreational activities for their congregation
  - Additional space to hold vacation bible school programs
  - A child care facility
  - An auditorium/fellowship hall that can be used for dinners and other events that are hosted within the community
  - Expansion of their parking area for the safety of the congregation and visitors
- 7. Supporting documents for justification purposes are attached and include:
  - Letter from Vera Shurley, ROW Agent/Navajo Land Department dated May 18, 2016
  - Consent to Use Navajo Nation Land for Religious Activities signed by Foster Gorman, dated March 07, 2016
