RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL 24th NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL -- First Year, 2019

AN ACT

RELATING TO BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE, NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE, AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT DOLLARS (\$1,374,278) FOR THE 110 NAVAJO NATION CHAPTER OFFICIAL STIPENDS AND WORKER'S COMPENSATION, BUSINESS UNIT NUMBERS 108014-108123; WAIVING 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(F) AND (L) REGARDING THE RESTRICTION OF APPROPRIATIONS OF NON-RECURRING REVENUES TO RECURRING COSTS; WAIVING 12 N.N.C. § 820(O) REGARDING THE "DISTRIBUTION TO CHAPTERS" FORMULA

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Navajo Nation established the Budget and Finance Committee ("BFC") as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee and as such empowered BFC to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 300 (A), 301 (B)(2).
- B. The Navajo Nation established the Resources and Development Committee ("RDC") as a Navajo Nation Council standing committee and as such gave RDC oversight over Navajo Nation Chapters. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 500 (A), 501 (C)(1).
- C. The Navajo Nation Council established the Naabik'íyáti' Committee as a Navajo Nation standing committee and as such proposed legislation that requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 164 (A)(9), 700 (A).

SECTION TWO. TITLE 12 FINANCE ACT SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION PROCESS

- A. The Title 12 Finance Act Supplemental Appropriation requirements include:
 - Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(L), when the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections, supplemental appropriations may be allocated by the Navajo Nation Council.
 - 2. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (L), "Supplemental appropriations made from non-recurring revenues shall only be made for non-recurring operations or purposes, as set forth at § 820 (F). The Controller of the Navajo Nation shall be responsible for designating recurring and non-recurring revenues and purposes."
 - 3. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(M), all requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget ("OMB") for budget impact analysis.
 - 4. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(0), "fifty percent (50%) of the appropriation shall be divided equally among all chapters and the remaining fifty percent (50%) shall be divided proportionately among the chapters using a percentage equal to that figure which the number of registered voters in each chapter bears to the whole of registered Navajo Nation votes as determined by the most current voter registration figures available as of the date of the appropriation."

SECTION THREE. FINDINGS

A. The Navajo Division of Community Development requests a supplemental appropriation on behalf of 110 Navajo Nation Chapters from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance in the amount of \$1,374,278 for chapter official stipend and worker's compensation. See "Supplemental Funding Proposal Summary" attached hereto within Exhibit A.

- B. Pursuant to the 2019 Budget Instructions Manual Section XIV.
 B. and C., the requisite supplemental funding request budget forms are attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- C. The Office of Management and Budget provided a Budget Impact Analysis, as **Exhibit C**, for the supplemental funding request pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(M).
- D. The Office of the Controller has provided a memorandum dated May 6, 2019, indicating the balance in the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance as of April 10, 2019 is \$42,334,700. This memorandum is provided to meet the requirements of 12 N.N.C, 820 (L). The Controller of the Navajo Nation designated the funds for the chapter official stipends and worker's compensation as a recurring cost. This memorandum is attached hereto as **Exhibit B**.
- E. The Navajo Nation finds it in the best interest of the Navajo people to approve this supplemental appropriation request. It is also in the best interest to waive the restriction of appropriations of non-recurring revenues to recurring costs as stated 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(F) and (L) and to waive the requirement regarding the "Distribution to Chapters" formula as stated in 12 N.N.C. § 820(O).

SECTION FOUR. APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,374,278 FOR 110 NAVAJO NATION CHAPTERS, BUSINESS UNIT NUMBERS 108014-108123

- A. This supplemental appropriation of \$1,374,278 shall be from that amount of funds that exceeds the minimum fund balance of the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance as determined by the Office of the Controller and to the 110 Navajo Nation Chapters, Business Unit Numbers 108014-108123.
- B. The Navajo Nation hereby approves supplemental funding from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance in the amount of \$1,374,278 for the 110 Navajo Nation Chapters, Business Unit Numbers 108014-108123, to fund the unmet need of the chapter official stipends and worker's compensation.

C. The supplemental funding will be deposited with each of the 110 Navajo Nation Chapters as described in **Exhibit A**.

SECTION FIVE. WAIVING 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(F) AND (L) REGARDING THE RESTRICTION OF APPROPRIATIONS OF NON-RECURRING REVENUES TO RECURRING COSTS

The Navajo Nation Council hereby waives 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(F) and (L) with regard to the restriction of appropriations of non-recurring revenues to recurring costs.

SECTION SIX. WAIVING 12 N.N.C. § 820(O) REGARDING THE DISTRIBUTION TO CHAPTERS FORMULA

The Navajo Nation Council hereby waives 12 N.N.C. \$ 820(0) with regard to the "Distribution to Chapter" formula.

SECTION SEVEN. EFFECTIVE DATE

The provisions of this Act shall become effective in accord with 2 N.N.C. \S 221(B).

REASON FOR REQUEST AND STATEMENT OF NEED: In Fiscal Year 2019, the Navajo Nation 110 Chapters did not receive adequate funds to fully pay stipends for all Chapter Officials for their twelve (12 planning an regular meetings and the four (4) agency council meetings. The result of this unmet needs would conduct less meetings that the Chapter Officials can conver and would affect the business that the Chapter membership can host. This would disrupt progress at the Chapter on approving any new or old business bein placed on Chapter agenda. There is an overall decrease in the Chapter budget for the last three (3) years. The FY 2019 Chapter Planning base amount was \$13,445,759. Again, this is another impact to the Chapter Officials stipends where there is a need of \$1,334,678 and this includes additional funding for worker compensation in the amount of \$38,280 plus \$1,320 to cover LGA Certified Chapters, difference totaling \$1,374,278. Review of Legislation No. 0122-19 Proposed Supplemental Funding from the UUFB in the amount of \$1,374,278 to 110 Navajo Nation Chapter Official Stipends and Worker's Compensation.

Pursuant to 12 NNC 820 (M), OMB reviewed the subject legislation and provides the following information:

- OMB reviewed an Executive Review budget request several months ago. The corrections have been made.
- 2. Explanation should be provided on why the funding level is not sufficient. Like all Executive Branch entities, every year planning allocations are given to DCD and the Chapters. DCD has the duty to budget the amounts to priorities. It seems the Chapters are underbudgeted so that additional funds must be eventually found. What are the carryover balances?
- Similarly, the Grazing Committee, Farm Boards and Land Boards are not funded for every scheduled meeting so additional funds must be found. DCD and OPVP should adequately plan on how to address these Chapter-level needs.
- 4. The FY 2019 budget resolution, CS-68-18, at Section Two has paragraph "M" that directs Branch Chiefs to prioritize any unmet budget needs and submit budget proposals for the selected priorities. Is this a priority and is there a priority list?
- 5. The legislation, page one, has Budget and Finance Committee first and then Resource and Development Committee. All the prior years this sequence was reversed. Is this correct?
