improving BIA N2 Road

Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. 1005 (C) (10), action for Legislation CJ-33-15, is being submitted to the Navajo Nation Council, through the Office of the Speaker, within the ten (10) days requirement. Furthermore, the Navajo Nation President has line item veto authority for budget items within the annual Navajo Nation Comprehensive Budget or Supplemental appropriations, which are not subject to override by the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. 164(A)(17)

After careful consideration and consultation with the Divisions, I have decided to exercise my line-item veto authority and veto \$31,780 for Tsidi To'ii Chapter for Improving BIA N2 Road.

There is sufficient funding within the current Chapter fund balance. The Chapter should be fully expending its funds before seeking supplement funding. Additionally, the Chapters proposed fiscal year 2016 budget will remain the same as the previous fiscal year. As such, we recommend the Chapter plan accordingly to include this project within the 2016 fiscal year budget.

As we face upcoming challenges with the budget deficit, the Navajo Nation, including all three branches, must be prudent in the use of the Undesignated, Unreserved Fund Budget.

AN ACTION

RELATING TO BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE AND THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$31,780 FOR TSIDI TO'II CHAPTER FOR IMPROVING BIA N2 ROAD

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS

- A. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (L), "[t]he Navajo Nation Council may adopt and approve supplemental appropriations to the Annual Comprehensive Budget during the fiscal year. Supplemental appropriations of General Funds within the current fiscal year are permitted, if and when additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections are projected and which are also in excess of the reserve amount set forth at § 820(J)."
- B. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(9), a proposed resolution that requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee before it is heard by the Navajo Nation Council.
- C. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 300 (C)(1)(3) and (4) the Budget and Finance Committee is authorized to recommend adoption of resolutions related to the expenditure of the Nation's financial resources.
- D. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C. § 3(A), Tsidi To'ii Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government.
- E. The community of Tsidi To'ii is in Navajo and Coconino counties within which is BIA Route 2 (N2), a dirt road of approximately four (4) miles primarily used as a bus route and for local resident's daily access, and which becomes impassable during times of inclement weather creating

- dangerous and unsafe road conditions. See Tsidi To'ii Chapter Resolution, TT-03-011-15, attached as Exhibit A.
- F. The Tsidi To'ii Chapter requires supplemental appropriations to improve the safety of the community road, BIA N2, and for an environmental assessment and corresponding biological evaluation. Budget Forms attached as Exhibit B.
- G. The Title 12 Finance Act Supplemental Appropriation requirements include:
 - Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(M), all requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget ("OMB") for budget impact analysis. Attached as Exhibit C.
 - 2. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(M), when the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections, supplemental appropriations may be allocated by the Navajo Nation Council. Attached as Exhibit D.
- H. The Navajo Nation finds it in the best interest to approve Supplemental Appropriation for the Tsidi To'ii Chapter for an environmental assessment and corresponding biological evaluation.

SECTION 2. APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$31,780 FOR THE TSIDI TO'II CHAPTER

- A. The Navajo Nation Council, having received certification by the Office of the Controller of the availability of certain funds from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance (UUFB) for supplemental appropriation hereby approves the supplemental appropriation of \$31,780 for Tsidi To'ii for an environmental assessment, as further described in budget documents attached.
- B. This supplemental appropriation of \$31,780 shall be to Business Unit Number 108106 and from that amount of funds that exceeds the minimum fund balance of the UUFB.



REQUESTING BIA, NAVAJO DIVISION OF TRANSPORTATION, NAVAJO COUNTY SUPERVISOR THOMPSON, AND COCONINO COUNTY SUPERVISOR METZGER, TO COLLABORATE WITH OUR CHAPTER TO IMPROVE ROUTE N2

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3 (A), Tsidi To'ii Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C. part 1, Section 10; and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1 (B), Tsidi To'ii Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community to take appropriate actions when necessary and make recommendations to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions; and
- 3. The community of Birdsprings is in two (2) counties, the Navajo County and the Coconino County, which land is divided by the Little Colorado River; the residents on the south side of the Little Colorado River have resided in that region for most of their lives and they have been able to make the best of their circumstances during inclement weather; and
- 4. BIA Route 2 is located south of the Little Colorado River, it is a BIA dirt road that stretches for about seven (7) miles; and
- 5. Route N2 is utilized as a school bus route for students attending Little Singer Community School, Inc. and it is a route many local residents utilize to tend to the daily routines of life; it is a route that is traveled by many during decent weather; and
- 6. The inclement weather causes flooding along BIA Route 2 and the roads that lead to and from homes becomes impassable; thus the inclement weather creates dangerous and unsafe road conditions for school busses, elderly drivers, individuals conducting business in the community, and emergency response vehicles; and
- 7. Some of the families see a doctor on weekly basis and impassable roads create a crisis for these families; and

- 8. Furthermore, the Little Singer Community School is also located three (3) miles north of the Little Colorado River, which serves the families and if the children do not attend school their studies suffer, due to impassable roads; and
- 9. The Coconino County Transportation Department, BIA, Navajo County Transportation Department, and the Navajo Department of Transportation are entrusted with oversight authority on county and tribal roads transportation infrastructure planning and development; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The Tsidi' To'ii Chapter hereby respectfully request BIA Roads Department, the Navajo Department of Transportation, Navajo County Supervisor Thompson, and Coconino County Supervisor Metzger to Collaborate with our Chapter to Improve Route N2; and
- 2. The Coconino County Transportation Department, BIA, Navajo County Transportation Department, Navajo Department of Transportation, and the Tsidi To'ii Chapter share the responsibility to improve BIA Route 2, so that children could maintain regular school attendance and not fall behind in their studies; and that families that are in need of medical appointments or in need of medical attention can travel to their appointments.

- 1. The supplemental request form is not attached to this proposed packet. According to the FY 15 Budget Instructions Manual, X. Supplemental Funding Request Policies and Procedures; B. Procedures, #1: "Navajo Nation programs and entities seeking supplemental funding shall use the Supplemental Funding Request Form (Appendix J) and budget forms 1 through 5 and follow the instructions provided in the current Navajo Nation Budget Instructions Manual. Any incomplete or inaccurate budget proposal will be returned to the program for corrections. If corrections are not made and not submitted in a timely manner, the proposal will not be recommended for funding."
- 2. The proposed packet does not indicate if Tsidi Toii is a LGA Certified or a non-LGA Certified Chapter. This should be provided by the chapter.
- 3. The proposed packet does not contain a Chapter resolution indicating support of this request.
- 4. The proposed packet also does not indicate if this request from Tsidi Toii Chapter part of the approved 5 year Capital Improvement Plan, CAP-18-14. The Division of Community Development should regularly provide this information pursuant to the Appropriations Act.



SUBJECT . Financial Update-(General Fund Revenue, Expenditures, UUFB)

The following is the financial data from the General Fund for FY 2015. The total year to date gross General Fund Revenues, see Exhibit "A", as of April 30, 2015 is \$162,094,626 and the total set asides is \$45,877,033. The Net Revenue for the General Fund is \$116,217,593 which is 67.31% of the projection. The total expenditures by branch are shown on Exhibit "B". The Legislative Branch has actual expenditures of \$7,253,038, encumbrances of \$886,761, with a remaining budget of \$10,053,148. The Executive Branch actual expenditures are \$115,459,028, encumbrances of \$15,118,928, with a remaining budget of \$83,706,591. The Judicial Branch actual expenditures are \$7,733,510, encumbrances of \$41,846 and remaining budget of \$7,866,347. Total General Fund expenditures are \$130,445,576; total encumbrances are \$16,047,534 leaving an overall remaining General Fund budget of \$101,626,086. After recalculating CAP-12-15, the revised UUFB as of May 18, 2015 is \$4,906,679, attached Exhibit "C."
