RESOLUTION OF THE RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE Of the 23rd Navajo Nation Council---First Year 2015

AN ACTION

RELATING TO RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT; APPROVING AND RECOMMENDING TO THE BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE THE PROPOSED FISCAL YEAR 2016 BUDGET FOR THE NAVAJO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. FINDINGS

- A. The Resources and Development Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. §500(A).
- B. The Resources and Development Committee is the oversight committee for the Navajo Environmental Protection Agency. 2 N.N.C. §501(C)(1).
- C. Each oversight committee shall review and make recommendations to the Budget and Finance Committee concerning the budget in accordance with the annual budget instructions. 12 N.N.C. §840(A).
- D. The Resources and Development Committee held a budget hearing and took budget testimony regarding the Navajo Environmental Protection Agency's Fiscal Year 2016 Budget. 12 N.N.C. §840(A).
- E. The Resources and Development Committee recommends to the Budget and Finance Committee a fiscal year budget for the Navajo Environmental Protection Agency. 12 N.N.C. §840(A).

SECTION TWO. APPROVING AND RECOMMENDING TO BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE THE PROPOSED FISCAL YEAR 2016 BUDGET FOR NAVAJO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

A. The Resources and Development Committee hereby acknowledges the proposed Navajo Nation Fiscal Year (FY) 2016 Budget for the Navajo Environmental Protection Agency, recommended by

- the President of the Navajo Nation, as provided on the Fund Type Budget Summary, attached as Exhibit "A".
- B. The Resources and Development Committee request that the Budget and Finance Committee and the Navajo Nation Council adopt the changes to the Budget, as set forth in the General Fund Comparative Summary and Recommended Changes to the General Fund Budget forms, attached as Exhibit "B" and "C", respectively.
- C. The Resources and Development Committee requests that the Budget and Finance Committee and the Navajo Nation Council approve the carryover of General Fund unexpended balances from Navajo Nation Fiscal Year 2015 into Fiscal Year 2016 as follows:
 - 1. All unexpended balances within the Navajo Nation EPA Administration Business Unit No. 111001 in the amount of \$10,944.00, or remaining balances; and
 - 2. All unexpended balances within the Navajo Nation EPA Criminal Enforcement Department Business Unit NO. 111014 in the amount of \$22,727.00, or remaining balances; and
- D. The Resources and Development Committee requests the Budget and Finance Committee and the Navajo Nation Council acknowledge the unmet needs as follows:
 - 1. \$41,909.00 for the Surface and Ground Water Protection Department, Business Unit 111004, for Information Systems Tech; and
 - 2. \$36,518.00 for the IAQ (Air and Toxic Department), in a new Business Unit number, for a tribal vehicle to be used to collect data for the indoor air quality studies; and
 - 3. \$18,351.00 for the Resources Conservation and Recovery Program, Business Unit 111011, for fleet, travel expenses and supplies to implement the Navajo Nation Solid Waste Act
 - 4. \$336,001.00 for the San Juan River Environmental Sampling, in a new Business Unit number, for four (4) Temporary Position (Environmental Technicians), fleet

vehicles, mileages, non-capital equipment, other Technical Services, and Insurance Premiums.

E. The Resources and Development Committee authorizes the Committee Chairperson or Vice-Chairperson to meet and negotiate with the Budget and Finance Committee on these recommendations.
